SHORT RIDE

(from Downtown Welcome Center)

- Downtown Market**
Hub of local food innovation offers artisan food vendors, cooking classes and more. Open until 7 pm seven days a week.
- West Side Corridor**
Home to breweries, restaurants, hipsters and shops.
- Uptown**
Walkable shopping and dining neighborhood made up of four historic districts.
- Fulton Street Farmers Market**
The city's oldest and largest farm market. Openers both summer and winter tours.
- John Ball Zoo**
Classic urban zoo with 1,500+ animals plus rare and adventures. Open until 6 pm in summer.
- Kent Trails Trailhead**
Entry point to 20+ miles of paved and unpaved trails, wetlands and small towns.
- Riverside Park**
Tree-lined park along the Grand River with disc golf, boat launch and ball fields.
- Circle Theatre**
Historic theatre stage shows for Main Streetmen as well as summer concerts.
- Mines Golf Course**
18-hole course built atop old gypsum mines.
- Gaslight Village**
Walkable shopping and dining district adjacent to beautiful Reed's Lake.
- DeltaPlex Arena**
35 miles away offers arena, bars, concerts, festivals and Grand Rapids Dive basketball.
- Millennium Park**
5.5 miles. One of America's largest urban parks offers boating, swimming, biking and plenty of green space.



KIDS' PLAY

- Summer Fun**
Visit the sugar-sand beaches of Lake Michigan, ride up towering sand dunes, big 25+ miles of shoreline, and enjoy the sun. Soak up the sun at Millington Park—giant splashpad, six-acre beach, swimming, fishing and more.
- Winter Fun**
Ice skate at Rosa Parks Circle, cheer on the Grand Rapids Griffins hockey team, ride the carousel at Grand Rapids Public Museum, explore hands-on exhibits at Grand Rapids Children's Museum and play endless games at Chuck E. Cheese's, Dave & Buster's or Craig's Cruisers.
