- Must be able to work a fluctuating work schedule that will vary depending on events schedule (including days, evenings, weekends, holidays, etc.)
- Knowledge of customer service practices
- Able to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Ability to perform tasks unsupervised as well as helps lead others.
- Previous conversions and/or general labour experience

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist in facility operations, Maintenance and ice maintenance.
- Assist in event conversions and operations.
- Performs other duties as assigned

Physical Demands & Work Environment:

• The Part Time Event Operations Labourer is a physically demanding position. The incumbent must spend the entire time at work standing, walking, lifting heavy objects. The incumbent is required to do a great deal of stretching and bending, often in awkward positions. The Employee will occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds unassisted.
