

BLOOMING POPPIES

SOUTHERN NEW MEXICO

LATE MARCH-EARLY APRIL Venture into fields of pure, velvety gold Mexican poppies that decorate the dusty foothills of Las Cruces. Winter moisture and sunny days determine the timing and quantity of the flowers, which can be viewed from your car and from hiking trails on both the east and west slopes of the Organ Mountains along Aguirre Springs and Baylor Canyon roads. Head to the Rockhound State Park area near Deming for access to poppies around the Little Florida Mountains; tangerine blooms can be spotted north of Lordsburg.
