## FOR THE ENTERTAINMENT ENTHUSIAST

### One-Day Visit

Albuquerque is packed with a variety of experiences that will entertain everyone in your group, whether you are looking for city tours, live music or immersive cultural activities.

- Start at the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center** to learn about the state's Native American heritage. Have breakfast at the **Indian Pueblo Kitchen**, tour the museum and watch a cultural dance performance in the courtyard.
- Head west down historic Route 66 to take a tour of the **KiMo Theatre**, a unique example of Pueblo Deco architecture that has been in continuous operation since 1927 and is rumored to be haunted.
  - You can also catch movies and performances here year-round; check out [cabq.gov/arts/culture/kimo](http://cabq.gov/arts/culture/kimo) for a schedule.
- For lunch, try a dish from **505 Central Food Hall**, home to local vendors specializing in everything from tacos and pizza to ramen and burgers.
- Next, get an introduction to the city on the **ABQ Trolley Co.** "Best of ABQ City Tour."
  - Or, check out a specialized tour, including **Routes Bicycle Tours & Rentals'** Biking Bad Tour or the popular **Breaking Bad Luigi's Tours** or **Breaking Bad RV Tours**.
- Conclude the day with an exciting evening of live music and local brews at **Marble Brewery**.
  - For dinner, take your pick of local food truck fare to enjoy on their rooftop patio that overlooks downtown Albuquerque.



### If You Have More Time

Take in more of the city's nightlife, which is much like its daytime lifestyle—perfectly placed to enjoy natural surroundings, full of craft breweries and overflowing with local artists.

- Enjoy a creative cocktail alongside breathtaking views at one of the city's many rooftop bars, such as **Apothecary Lounge**, **G. Toti**, or **Level 5**.
- Solid watering holes any day of the week, **The Smoky Note** in Nob Hill and other Downtown spots offer live music most days of the week.
- Downtown ABQ has become a true destination for local suds, and you can keep the night moving with a seat on the **Duke City Pedaler**—a 14-passenger party bike that cycles between local breweries.
- Head to one of the area's casino resorts to enjoy gaming, a variety of musical entertainment and top-notch dining.
