One-Day Visit

Albuquerque's shops are filled with unique items that reflect the city's vibrant character. Look for the "New Mexico True Certified" label to find locally handcrafted products. If you're still craving the flavors of Albuquerque after you get home, order a custom gift set from **ABQ In a Box**, **Flyby Provisions** or **New Nuevo**.

- Begin the day with a cappuccino and breakfast at **The Grove Café & Market** and peruse their collection of gifts, cookbooks and boutique grocery products.
- Head to the **Historic Old Town** neighborhood, which is home to a variety of merchants and is an ideal spot to find a one-of-a-kind gift or souvenir.
- Stop at **D.H. Lescombes Winery & Bistro** for lunch and a tasting of their award winning New Mexico wines (and even purchase a bottle or two)!
- Shop 'til you drop by visiting **Winrock Town Center**, a pedestrian-friendly open-air shopping mall, and Coronado Center, which offers an array of stores, dining and entertainment options.

- End the day with a visit to **Sawmill Market**, New Mexico's first artisanal food hall featuring a mix of restaurant and retail options.

- **Historic Old Town:** With a variety of unique merchants, this is the place to shop for Albuquerque essentials.
- **Downtown/EDo:** This neighborhood is home to a handful of fine-art galleries, as well as weekly farmers' markets that take place from spring through fall that spotlight the state's agriculture and artisans.
- **Nob Hill:** As one of the city's most vibrant and historic neighborhoods, Nob Hill is home to extensive shopping options.
- **Uptown:** The place to go for a full-day shopping experience, with a variety of brand name and department stores.
- **North Valley/Los Ranchos:** This neighborhood is known for its vintage and antique shopping, as well as local agricultural goods made with ingredients from one of the many nearby farms.
