


#### **CULTURAL DIVERSITY**

Albuquerque also possesses a Hispan history that began in 1706 when Spanish Governor Francisco Cuervo v Valdes penned a letter to the Duke o Alburguerque reporting that he had founded a villa along the banks of the Rio Grande. Since then, the city -

named after the duke - has grown from a tiny settlement of families into a rich metropolis of more than 800,000 people. The National Hispanic Cultural Center is a wonderful resource within Albuquerque for meeting attendees to deepen their understanding of the city's Spanish and Mexican heritage.
