Things To Do Now

1. KING STREET & OLD TOWN

Stroll King Street, a walkable mile of centuries-old architecture at the heart of Old Town's 200+ independently owned restaurants and boutiques. Step off King Street for more shopping and dining plus picturesque row houses among red brick sidewalks and cobblestone streets.

2. WATERFRONT

The Potomac River provides a stunning background for outdoor dining, a vibrant arts scene, viewing D.C. monuments and cruises to regional attractions. Plus, discover the greatly expanded new park area at the foot of King Street for special happenings and panoramic views.

3. GEORGE WASHINGTON'S MOUNT VERNON

Step back in time at the first president's beautiful riverside estate, located just eight miles south of Old Town. Explore the mansion, working farm, tomb, visitor facilities with 25 galleries and theaters, and more.

4. TORPEDO FACTORY ART CENTER

Discover art in person and in progress at the nation's largest collection of workingartists' open studios under one roof. A fully operational munitions plant during WWII, the center is now home to 82 artists' studios, seven galleries, the Alexandria Archaeology Museum and The Art League School.

5. MARKET SQUARE MUSEUMS

See history where it happened at three sites—Carlyle House, Gadsby's Tavern Museum and the Stabler-Leadbeater Apothecary Museum—within one block. Save on admission with a Key to the City museum pass.

Tour the mansion and step inside one of the most iconic homes in the country, interact with history at the Museum and Education Center, visit animals and get a taste of 18th-century farm life at the Pioneer Farm.



MOST KNOWN FOR its colonial heritage, the timeline of Alexandria's history is filled with events that helped shape the United States. Founded by Scottish merchants in 1749, Alexandria was a vital seaport during colonial times, is George Washington's adopted hometown and was part of the original Washington, D.C. Here's a look at the neighborhoods waiting to be discovered in Alexandria today.

OLD TOWN

n the Potomac River waterfront, Old Town Alexandria is the heart of the city, filled with beautifully-preserved 18th- and 19th-century architecture and picturesque cobblestone streets and alleys. The brick-lined sidewalks hum with an energy that attracts everyone from D.C. locals to international visitors, who enjoy the city's best restaurants, arts and live music, events, shopping and historic attractions. Walkable King Street, recognized as one of the "Great Streets" of America, stretches one mile from the waterfront marina and the renowned Torpedo Art Factory Center toward the iconic George Washington Masonic National Memorial. Dine, shop and stroll at more than 200 independent boutiques and restaurants along the way.

In Old Town you'll find seasonal parades and festivals year-round, from the Campagna Center's Scottish Christmas Walk Weekend to the King Street Art Festival. On Saturday mornings, stop by the Old Town Farmers' Market at Market Square. It's one of the longest operating farmers markets in the country and where George Washington once traded goods. Need a break? Hop on the free King Street Trolley and enjoy the ride to your next destination on King Street. **DEL RAY**

here Main Street still ex-" ists," Del Ray features made-for-strolling Mount Vernon Avenue, buzzing with independent boutiques, community events and locally owned eateries that have food critics raving. Eclectic shops, extensive murals, Art Deco architecture and signature festivals like Art on the Avenue lend an artsy vibe to the area. The neighborhood is also known as "Well Ray" for its many yoga, barre and wellness businesses. Del Rav's the place where neighbors know each other and you can still find a local butcher, hardware store and pharmacy all on one street.

WEST END

A lexandria's West End is home to one of the top small breweries in the U.S., Port City Brewing Company, which offers tours and tastings, plus events like Beer Yoga and Pedals and Pints. The West End is known for international dining, including some of the best Thai, Vietnamese and Ethiopian food in the region. You'll also find historic parks like the 45-acre Civil War-era Fort Ward Museum & Historic Site, Dora Kelly Nature Park and Jerome "Buddie" Ford Nature Center, where you can see animals up close.

CARLYLE & EISENHOWER

n the southwestern part of the city, Carlyle and the Eisenhower Valley is Alexandria's contemporary counterpoint to historic Old Town. Known as an "economic engine of Alexandria." with scores of businesses taking root here, the neighborhood celebrates the spirit of science and innovation. The National Science Foundation is located in Carlyle, along with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. which is home to the National Inventors Hall of Fame museum. Take in Alexandria's history at the African American Heritage Park and the Edmonson Sisters sculpture. Outdoor spaces host community events and pop-up shops, and the dining scene keeps the mix of old and new fresh. with local favorites like Table Talk and Sweet Fire Donna's anchoring new spots like Tequila and Taco.

EVOLVING WATERFRONT



A busy seaport since colonial times, Alexandria juxtaposes historic authenticity and new happenings among a growing scene of D.C.-area waterfront destinations. Visitors flock to Alexandria's waterfront to enjoy boat cruises, outdoor dining, waterfront parks, stand-up paddle boarding, festivals and more. Here's a look at Alexandria's portside history, what's new and what's on the horizon.



1749 Alexandria is established, a year after teenage surveyor George Washington draws plans for the town.

1847 An international seaport from its start, the city ranks ninth in the U.S. in overall trade following cities like New York , New Orleans and Philadelphia.

1801 Alexandria becomes part of D.C. The city retroceded to Virginia in 1847, but you can still see the original boundary stone at Jones Point Park.





Virginia secedes from the Union, and Alexandria is quickly occupied by Union troops. PBS' *Mercy Street*, inspired by true stories of Civil War Alexandria and available on Amazon, follows two nurses on both sides of the conflict as well as African-Americans claiming their freedom. Today, visitors discover the stories of African-Americans who shaped Alexandria and America by exploring a historically rich collection of sites.

WATERFRONT FARE

Where to find fresh seafood and stunning riverfront views.



Nothing pairs better with fresh seafood than stunning views of the Potomac River. Enjoy waterfront fare like shrimp po-boys and Carolina low country steamer pails at **Vola's Dockside Grill**. Nearby on the marina is **Blackwall Hitch**, serving up local Chesapeake oysters, Prince Edward Island mussels and more. For more waterfront views, head to the iconic **Chart House** or Hummingbird, which is inspired by the American spirit of clambakes and crab boils, fish fries and oyster roasts. You don't have to stick to the waterfront to enjoy mouthwatering seafood. From Fish Market to The Wharf and from Hank's Oyster Bar to Augie's Mussel House, you'll find fresh fish and shellfish on restaurant menus throughout King Street.

HISTORIC CHARM

Can't-beat dishes served in an unforgettable atmosphere make these restaurants a must-try.



Vermilion 1120 King St. Tucked into an historic storefront, Vermilion is the place to impress a date with its locally-sourced menu praised by The Washington Post.


HISTORIC HOUSES

Step inside the first president's estate and a Frank Lloyd Wright dream home.









GEORGE WASHINGTON'S MOUNT VERNON

The most popular historic estate in America is located just eight miles south of Old Town Alexandria and is accessible by bike and by boat. Here, visitors get a glimpse into 18th-century life by exploring the mansion, gardens, working farm, distillery and gristmill, and interactive visitor facilities with 25 theaters and galleries honoring George Washington's life and legacy and legacy.

CARLYLE HOUSE

Completed in 1753, Carlyle House was the home of one of Alexandria's founders. Scottish merchant John Carlyle. It was one of the grandest mansions of its time and quickly became a center of social and political life. On the National Register of Historic Places, Carlyle House is architecturally unique in Alexandria as the only stone 18th-century mansion and stands today as a museum open to visitors.

FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S POPE-LEIGHEY HOUSE

Designed in the 1940s, Wright's "Usonian" Pope-Leighey House was created for a couple with a modest budget. Visitors enjoy tours of the residence. located on a 126-acre estate originally part of George Washington's Mount Vernon. The Pope-Leighey House measures just 1,200 square feet, but Wright's high ceilings, large expanses of glass and open floor plan create the illusion that it is much larger.

LEE-FENDALL HOUSE

The Lee-Fendall House Museum interprets 200 vears of American history through the changing lives and fortunes of the people who lived and worked in the house from 1785 to 1969. Located in Old Town and on the National Register of Historic Places for state significance and the Virginia Landmarks Register, visitors can tour the museum, view rotating exhibits, enjoy the garden and attend special events throughout the year.



1. MASONIC MEMORIAL

One of the most iconic buildings in Alexandria and an active Masonic temple, the George Washington Masonic National Memorial dates back to 1922 and shines in sunset photos.

2. "BEADED CURTAIN"

Located on the loading dock door of the Torpedo Factory Art Center, Erin Curtis' "Beaded Curtain" mural makes a coloful backdrop perfect for Instagram.

3. JONES POINT PARK

A favorite spot for sunrise photography, Jones Point Park is home to an 1855 lighthouse and the southern D.C. boundary stone, representing Alexandria's history of once being part of D.C.

4. HISTORIC HOUSES

Old Town is filled with colonial homes adorned with flags, colorful doors and flickering gas lamps. Stroll Alexandria's historic streets and snap streetscapes guaranteed to get likes.

5. COBBLESTONE CHARM

You don't have to walk far in Old Town to find a picturesque cobblestone alley. Plus, find two cobblestone blocks. Captain's Row, located at the 100 block of Prince Street, is the most iconic.

There's a ton. We go to Ichiban for sushi. Columbia Firehouse, Mia's and Vola's are at the top of the list.


WHERE TO GO IN THE REGION

- 221 King St. Re-creation of the circa 1724 home of Scottish merchant and city co-founder William Ramsay.
- 105 N. Union St. A torpedo factory during World War II, now home to 82 artists' studios and seven galleries.
- **3.** *100 block of Prince St.* One of two cobblestone blocks in the city, Captain's Row got its name from Captain John Harper, a successful overseas trader.
- 201 Prince St. Built in 1851 and now an art gallery, this antebellum Greek Revival building originally housed the Bank of the Old Dominion.
- 5. 105-107 S. Fairfax St. This family-run pharmacy operated from 1792 until 1933 and served customers like Martha Washington. Tour to view its vast collection of still-intact herbal botanicals, handblown glass and medical equipment.
- **6.** *301 King St.* Now City Hall, this structure was built in 1871 as a courthouse atop a site first used as a market space frequented by George Washington. Its farmers' market tradition continues each Saturday year-round.
- 121 N. Fairfax St. This Georgian Palladian manor house was built in 1753 by wealthy Scottish merchant and city cofounder John Carlyle.
- 8. 134 N. Royal St. Businessman John Wise built this twobuilding complex: the 1785 Georgian-style City Tavern and the 1792 Federal style City Hotel famous for its great ballroom. Ideally situated on the main stage coach route between Boston and Williamsburg, the tavern became an important political and social center, whose notable patrons included George Washington and Thomas Jefferson.

- 9. 508 Cameron St. Re-creation of a townhouse built by George Washington in 1769 to provide convenient quarters when business or inclement weather prevented his return to Mount Vernon.
- 523 Queen St. Now a private residence, the skinniest historic house in America, built in 1830 to keep loiterers out of the adjacent alley, is just 7 feet wide.
- **11.** *118 N. Washington St.* Built in 1773, this is an excellent example of a small rectangular Georgian church. The three-story tower with belfry topped by a cupola was completed in 1818. George Washington played a part in building the church and was an original pew-holder (number 60).
- **12.** *517 Prince St.* Built in 1775 and one of the least-altered homes in Alexandria, this timber frame and brick dwelling was around during the American Revolution.
- 13. 201 S. Washington St. Built in 1839, this building has served as a Civil War hospital, private home and the nation's first Bicentennial Center. Today, visitors enjoy viewing 1,500 historical objects at Alexandria's History Museum.
- 14. 1315 Duke St. Located in the former headquarters of the largest domestic slave trading company in the country, the Freedom House Museum preserves the powerful stories of the enslaved in the same space where they were once held.
- **15.** *goz Wythe St.* Originally the segregated library for Alexandria's African-American residents, the museum documents the local and national history, culture and contributions of black America.
