Economic Impact of Tourism

- \$754 million in visitor spending (2014)



- City-owned garages in Old Town Market Square Garage | 108 North Fairfax Street Courthouse Square Garage | 111 South Pitt Street Thompson's Alley Garage | 10 Thompson's Alley N Union Street Garage | 220 North Union Street South Henry Street Lot | 112 South Henry Street Cameron / St. Asaph Street Lot | 210 North St. Asaph Street
- Metered parking
 - Free on Sundays, or after 9 PM
 - 2 or 3 hour limit
 - Pango app
 - Check a block or two off King
- Valet parking at some restaurants/hotels
- Del Ray parking is free

- Reserved overnight parking available for \$40 per day at GW Masonic Memorial
- Loading and unloading in designated areas ONLY
- No idling when parked


