February Financial Report

Fiscal Year 2023.24 February 01, 2024 - February 29, 2024

Summary

Revenue and Sales:

- Total Revenues for February 2024 amounted to \$125,152.71 with an additional \$9,968.23 in Interest Income
- ACVB HOT disbursements totaled \$124,737.87. These are being dispersed as our portion of the HOT
 collections minus the debt service.
- The ACVB portion of HOT collections was \$78,397.13 under what was projected for February.
- Our website sales totaled \$404.84 with \$10.00 for shipping reimbursements.

Expenses and Cost Management:

Expenses for this month are under budget by ~\$28,716.84. This is primarily due to personnel expenses with our most recent staffing changes.

HOT Collections:

- Total HOT collections are down ~9% from this year's projections, an amount of \$260,860.
- February was down from projections by ~30%, \$182,926.
- Our office's portion is down \$111,797.14 from projections

Note on HOT Collections vs. Expenses

Looking ahead, we expect increased expenses in the forthcoming months, yet we currently remain under our planned expenditures for the year. HOT collections align with the previous year's trend, which culminated in approximately \$9.2 million, with approximately \$2.5 million attributed to the ACVB. For the fiscal year 2023.24, our operational budget is set at approximately \$2.4 million. After considering anticipated expenses, we find ourselves approximately \$126,000 below budget for the first quarter of 2023.24. We will evaluate STR reporting for Spring Break to give us a better idea of the 2024 travel season. This will help us in determining if we need to reevaluate our spending looking ahead.





Net Audience Growth, by Month





Impressions, by Month





Engagements, by Month





Engagement Rate (per Impression), by Month






