## THE LARGEST CONVENTION CENTER ON THE WEST COAST

The Anaheim Convention Center (ACC) is consistently ranked as one of the top meeting venues in the U.S. in terms of its size, attendance, overall building services and amenities.

The LEED® certified 1.8 million-square-foot ACC is the largest convention center on the West Coast. This ultra-modern facility boasts the capability to host mega-conventions, meetings, tradeshow and events with ease.

ACC offers over one million square feet of exhibit space including three ballrooms totaling 238,000 square feet. The 2017 expansion, ACC North, adds 200,000 square feet of space with a 100,000 square foot carpeted column-free multi-purpose space featuring north-facing windows and movable airwalls for a variety of meeting room layout options.

In addition, the picturesque outdoor Palm Courts, Arena Plaza and Grand Plaza offer sunny possibilities for year-round special events, receptions and networking.

# MORE REASONS TO CHOOSE THE ANAHEIM CONVENTION CENTER



## ACC NORTH

Opened in 2017, ACC North includes 100,000 square feet of carpeted space on the 100 level and an additional 100,000 square feet of carpeted, column-free space on the 200 level, with direct access to an over 10,000 square foot outdoor balcony. This expansion includes natural light on each level with blackout capabilities, up to 35 rooms on the 200 level and up to 13 rooms on the 100 level with meeting rooms grouped into neighborhoods to allow for customizable climate and lighting control. The multi-purpose rooms and pre-function spaces feature 2,000 lbs. on ten foot centers. That's over 2,100 points to hang!

## EXHIBIT SPACE

The ACC features over one million square feet of exhibit space, making it the largest exhibit facility on the West Coast. All halls are directly accessible from spacious pre-function areas.

## GRAND PLAZA

Featuring two beautiful cascading fountains, palm and orange trees, the Grand Plaza is the ideal year-round outdoor venue for lunches, receptions, outdoor exhibits and more. Located in front of the ACC, between the Hilton Anaheim and Anaheim Marriott, this area has 36,000 square feet of usable space.

## THE ARENA

The Arena is part of the convention center complex. It features 28,000 square feet (flat floor) and seats up to 7,500, much larger than most other convention center arenas.

## ARENA PLAZA

The Arena Plaza offers 64,000 square feet of usable space and can accommodate receptions up to 5,500 people. It includes a courtyard area with a dramatic fountain centerpiece.

Wheelchair and scooter rentals are subject to availability. It's recommended to reach out well before the event.

### ASL INTERPRETERS/CART SERVICES

Events are responsible for contracting with ASL Interpreters/CART Services.

### SERVICE ANIMALS

Under ADA regulations, the definition of a "service animal" is limited to a dog or a miniature horse that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. The task(s) performed by the animal must be directly related to the person's disability. Under the ADA, "comfort", "therapy", and/ or "emotional support" animals do not qualify as service animals.



### ACCESSIBLE PARKING

The most accessible parking options are available in Car Park 1 and Car Park 4. Let the attendant know you need ADA parking to be directed appropriately.

### ELEVATORS

- **ACC South:** One (1) elevator in Lobby D and one (1) elevator in Lobby B
- **ACC North:** Two (2) elevators, one (1) on each side of the lobby level

### ACCESSIBLE SEATING IN THE ACC ARENA

ADA seating is located on the Arena floor as there are no elevators located in the Arena.

### EMERGENCY EVACUATION

The Safe Rooms/Area of Refuge (on the 2nd & 3rd floors) are for mobility impaired guests that cannot traverse the emergency stairwells.

## FAMILY RESTROOMS & FACILITIES AT THE ANAHEIM CONVENTION CENTER

### FAMILY RESTROOMS:

Total of 6 conveniently located in Lobby A, ACC North Plaza Level, and other accessible areas.

### RESTROOMS WITH CHANGING TABLES:

- **ACC North:**  
Total of 15 restrooms: 10 standard (5 men's, 5 women's) and 5 dedicated family restrooms. Each features changing stations.
- **ACC South & Arena:**  
Total of 17 restrooms: 16 standard (8 men's, 8 women's) and 1 family restroom near Hall A. All equipped with changing stations.
- **Exhibit Halls:** Total of 22 restrooms: 12 standard (4 men's, 8 women's). Includes 10 with convenient counters for changing.
- **Meeting Rooms on 2nd & 3rd Floors:**  
Total of 14 restrooms: 8 standard (4 men's, 4 women's) with all having changing counters.

### MOTHER'S ROOM

There are **two (2) lactation rooms** available for use within ACC South: room 109 located in Lobby A and room 127 located in Lobby D. There is (1) lactation room located at ACC North on the Plaza Level.

### ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES:

- **ADA Accessible Doors:** 15 push-button doors are available for easy access and are located at key entry points, including Exhibit Halls A to E, and both ACC North and ACC Lobby entries.

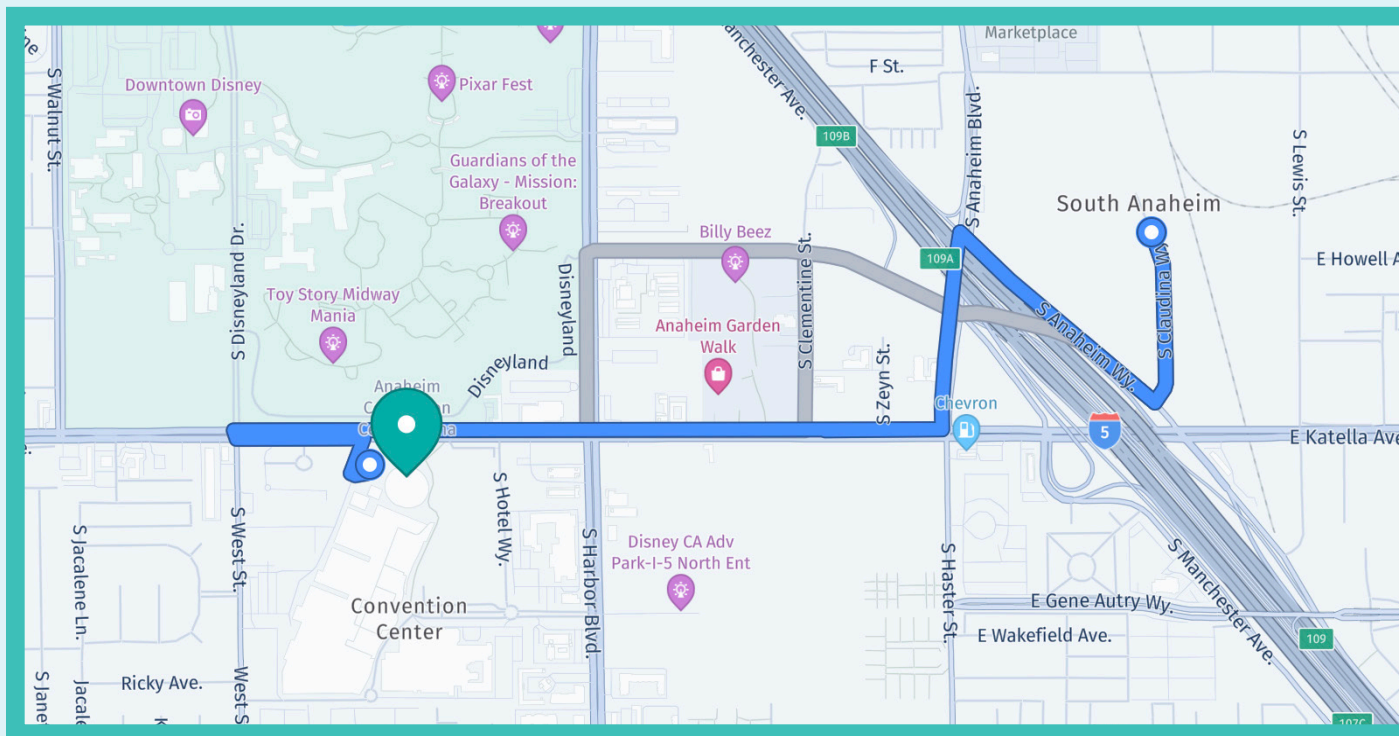
## CLAUDINA MARSHALING YARD

The Anaheim Convention Center (ACC) officially opened the Claudina Marshaling Yard, located on the corner of Anaheim Blvd. and Claudina Way. The 6 acres of on-grade asphalt is just off the 5 freeway, within 2 miles of the ACC.

The Claudina Marshaling Yard's proximity to the Anaheim

Convention Center is a significant advantage for event organizers. This yard enhances the efficient management of material handling for events, ensuring timely operations from start to finish. The yard supports everything from receiving freight and preparing for move-in and move-out to providing storage during event days, all of which contribute to smoother, streamlined event logistics.

**Below are common expenses for events at the Anaheim Convention Center (ACC). A complete list of potential charges are available, your event manager may provide an estimate for planning.**

### ACC PARKING

Parking is currently \$25 per day with no in and out privileges, no overnight parking. Rate subject to change.

### MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL

Medical services personnel is required during move in, event days and/or move out when there are over 300 attendees and if move in/out activity involves use of forklifts or aerial lifts.

### CROWD CONTROL PERSONNEL

Crowd Control personnel to include fire watch, ticket taking and public safety are exclusively provided by ACC personnel.

### SECURITY

Each event is required to have security personnel. ACC has the right to determine the minimum level of security required for each event. A minimum of one (1) security

personnel for every 500 attendees is required. If armed security is required, it needs to be scheduled through the ACC and provided by the Anaheim Police Department exclusively.

### ELECTRICAL

The ACC has contractual agreements with approved electrical providers. The client's selected electrical service provider is responsible for providing show power to all event areas as well as all food related portable concession locations within the facility. This includes any retail foods (i.e. outdoor food trucks, portables in the Arena Plaza, Grand Plaza areas) These are located outdoors and are part of the Anaheim Convention Center property.

### ROOM RESET FEES

Rental of each meeting room includes one complimentary standard set (classroom, theater or rounds.) Reset fees for either same day or overnight resets are billable at 50% of the prevailing room rental rate. Reset fees do not apply if the reset is to a catered function.

### TRASH AND CLEANING

The ACC cleans all common areas. Registration and/or exhibit areas are the responsibility of the general service contractor /client to arrange trash disposal. Drop off bins and compactors are an additional charge based on event needs.

### ACC LABOR OVERTIME

Personnel will be billed for extended service hours and on classified federal holidays.

- Double time will be charged for any electrician/HVAC technician labor calls that begin before 7:00AM and end after 11:30PM.
- Time-and-one-half will be charged for all personnel classifications, on holidays. Additional labor fees may apply based on event specifications.

### WATER SERVICE

Water bottle filling stations are available in all public lobbies and exhibit halls. Water service for speakers/head tables (individual water bottles) and water coolers are available for purchase through ACC Catering.

# ACC PLANNING TOOLKIT CONTINUED

## CHAIRS

General sessions held in the exhibit halls include a maximum of 2,000 complimentary chairs. Additional chairs are provided at prevailing rates.

## TABLE LINENS

Standard table linens will be provided for meeting rooms with meal service set in rounds. Upgraded linens are an additional charge. All meetings set in rounds, without meal service, will incur a per table linen fee. Classroom set includes complimentary vinyl table coverings. If linens are preferred for classroom style set up, a per-table linen fee will apply.

## ROOM KEY AND REKEYS

There is a charge to rekey meeting rooms to high-secure a room. Up to five (5) complimentary copies of the key may be provided. Additional copies are chargeable. A replacement fee will apply if keys are lost.

## ADVERTISING / BRANDING

Sponsorship and advertising include banners, signs or other

items that are displayed in public areas are subject to a flat rate or a percentage of sponsorship. Your ACC event manager will provide a copy of the fees and guidelines.

## UNIONS

Union workers are not required; however, unions are represented in the building and most general contractors utilize union workers and have union guidelines.

## FLOORPLAN APPROVAL

Client is responsible to submit floor plans for approvals to both Anaheim Fire & Rescue and ACC management prior to any sales of exhibit space. Approvals are required with a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the event.

*Fees apply for submitting plans to AF&R.*

## CAD DRAWINGS / DIAGRAMS

Client AV company, general service contractor or production company is responsible for creating diagrams or CAD drawings.

for non-exhibit events. House sound is exclusively managed through Encore. Mixing of sound systems is not permitted.

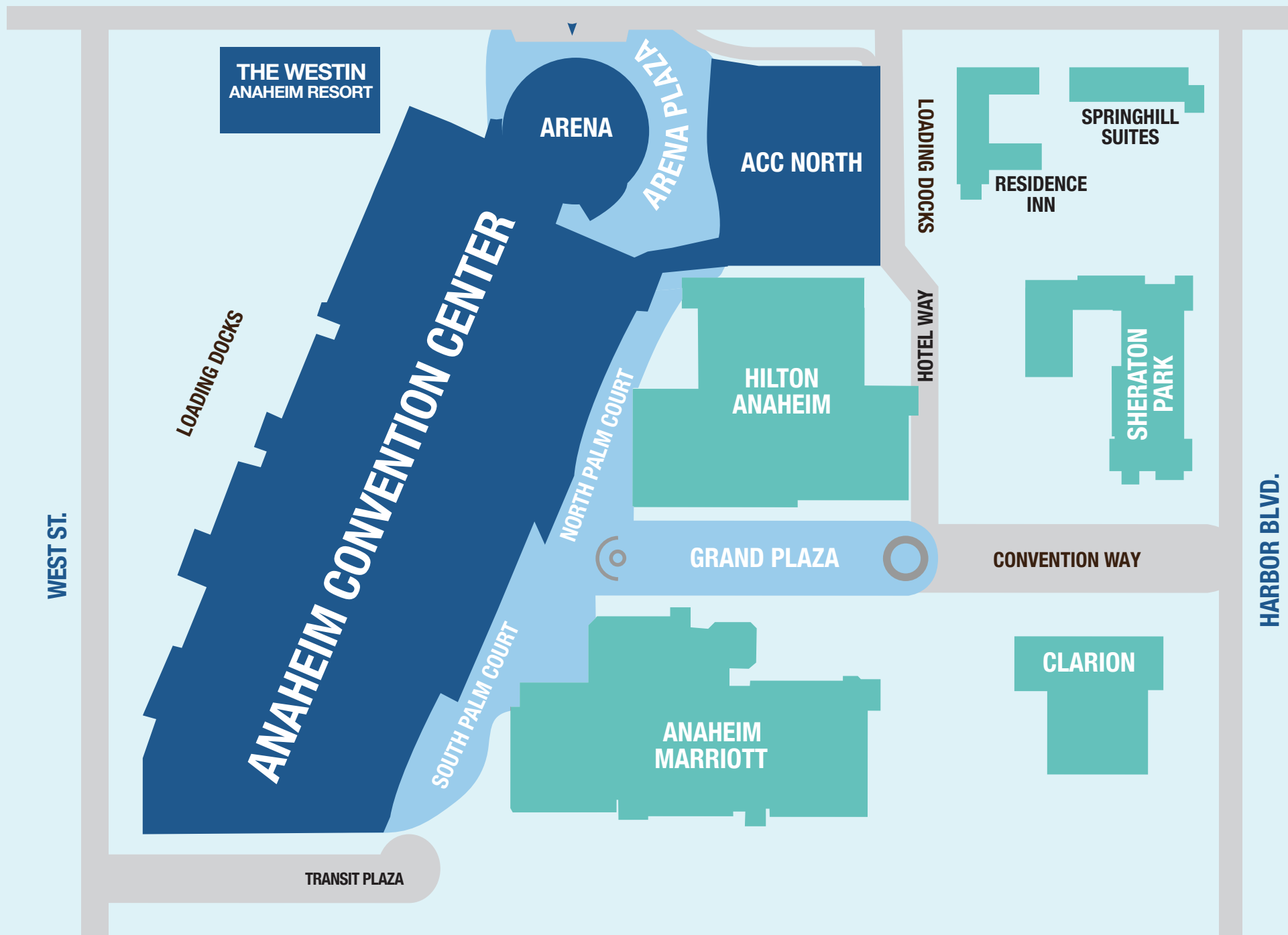

### CULINARY EXPERIENCES

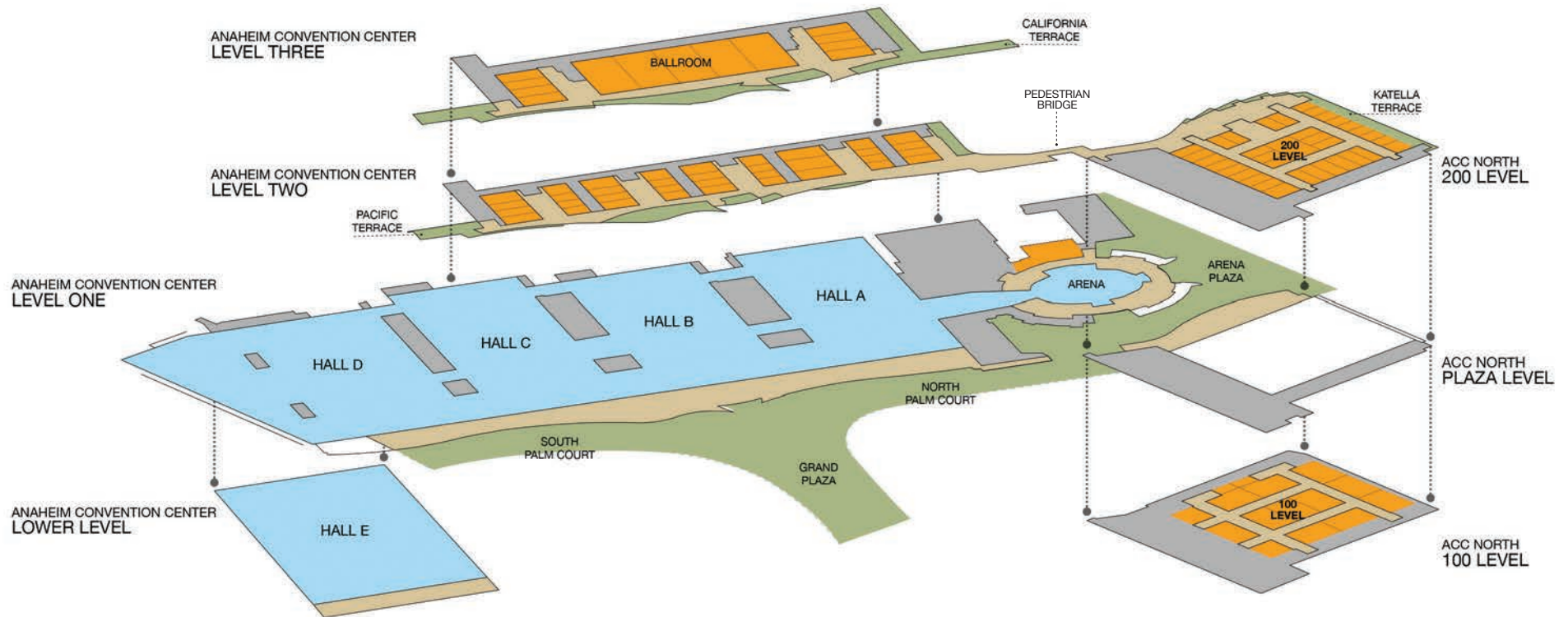

# ACC TRI LEVEL FLOOR PLAN DIAGRAM

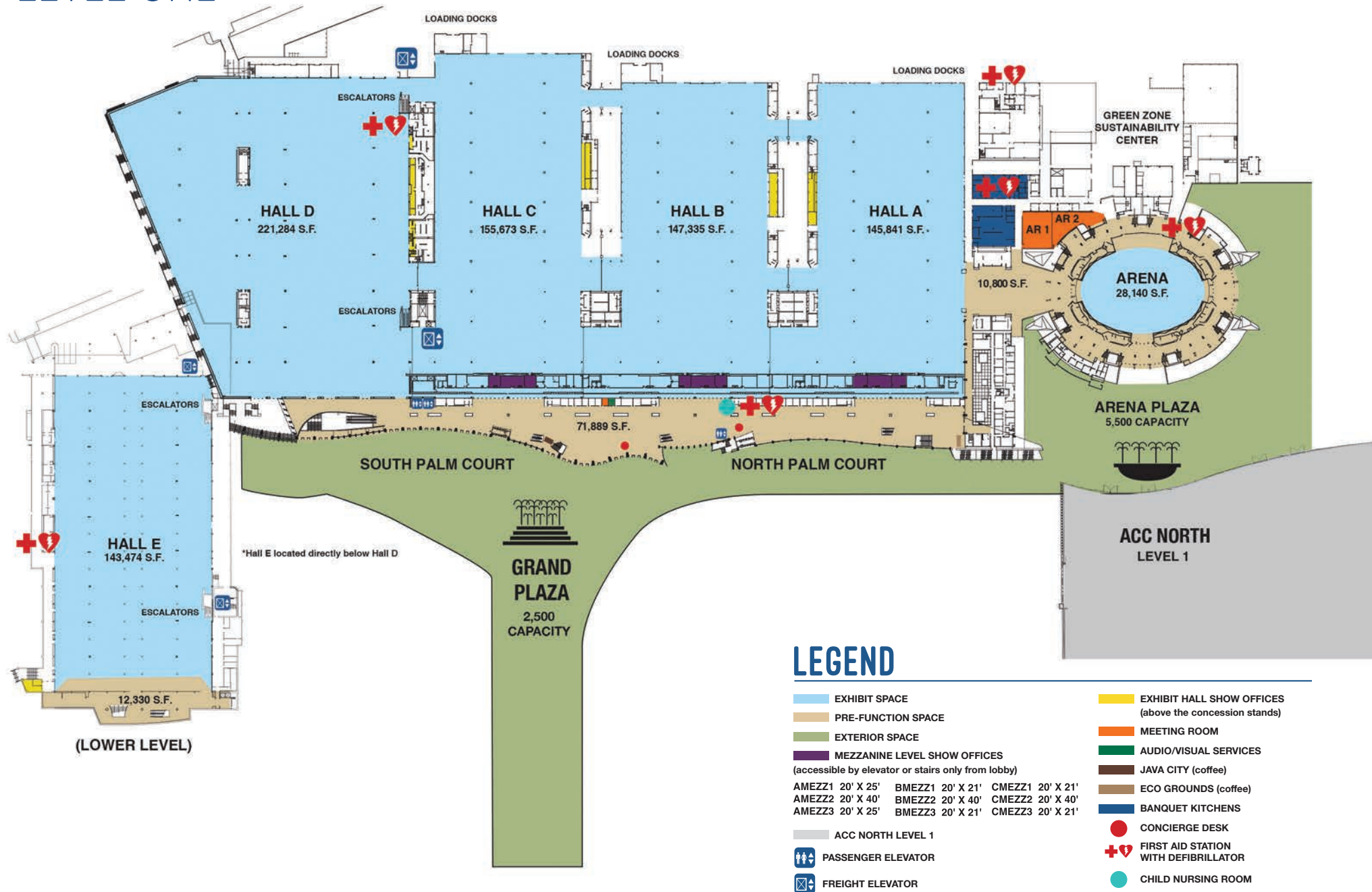

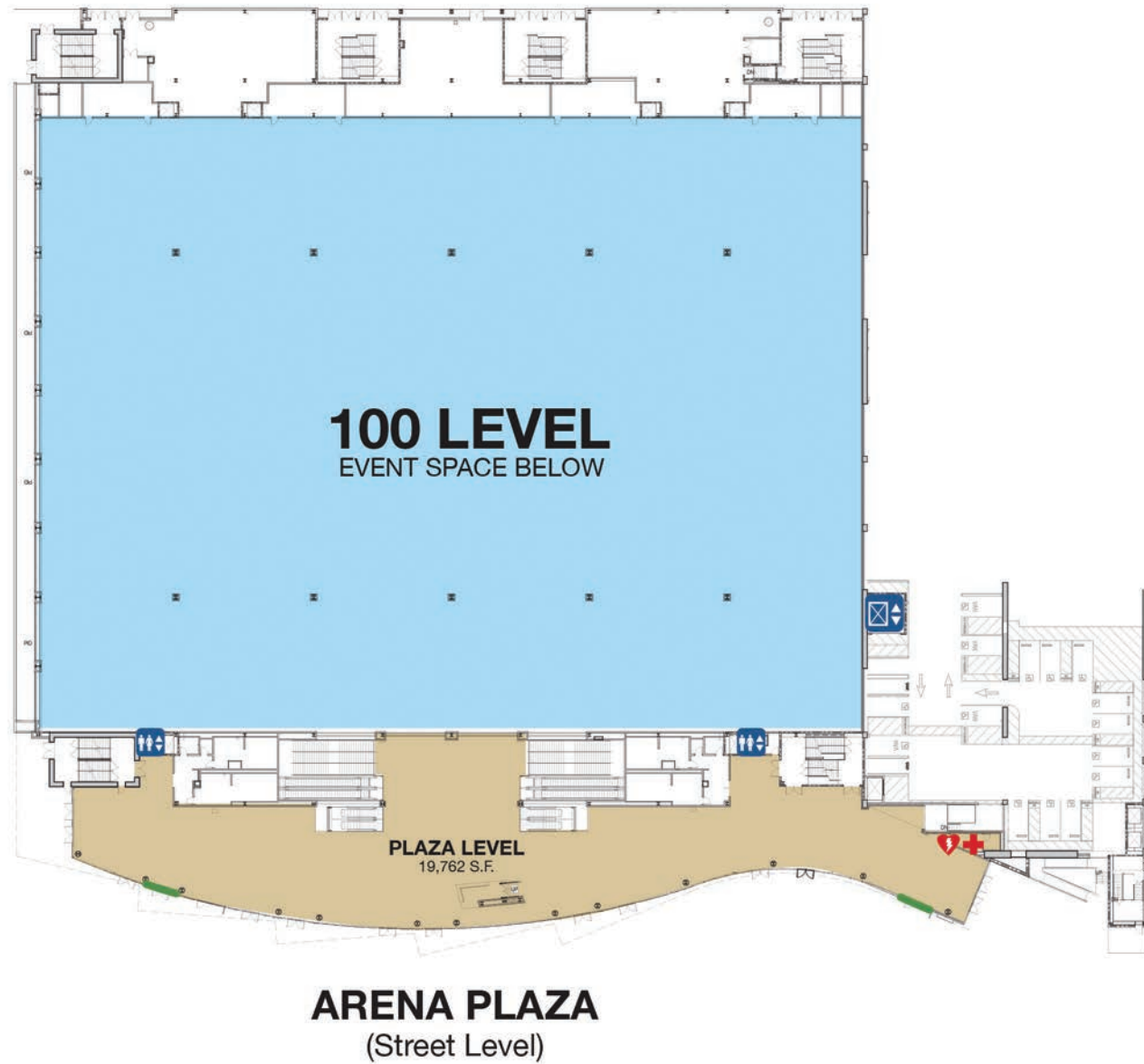

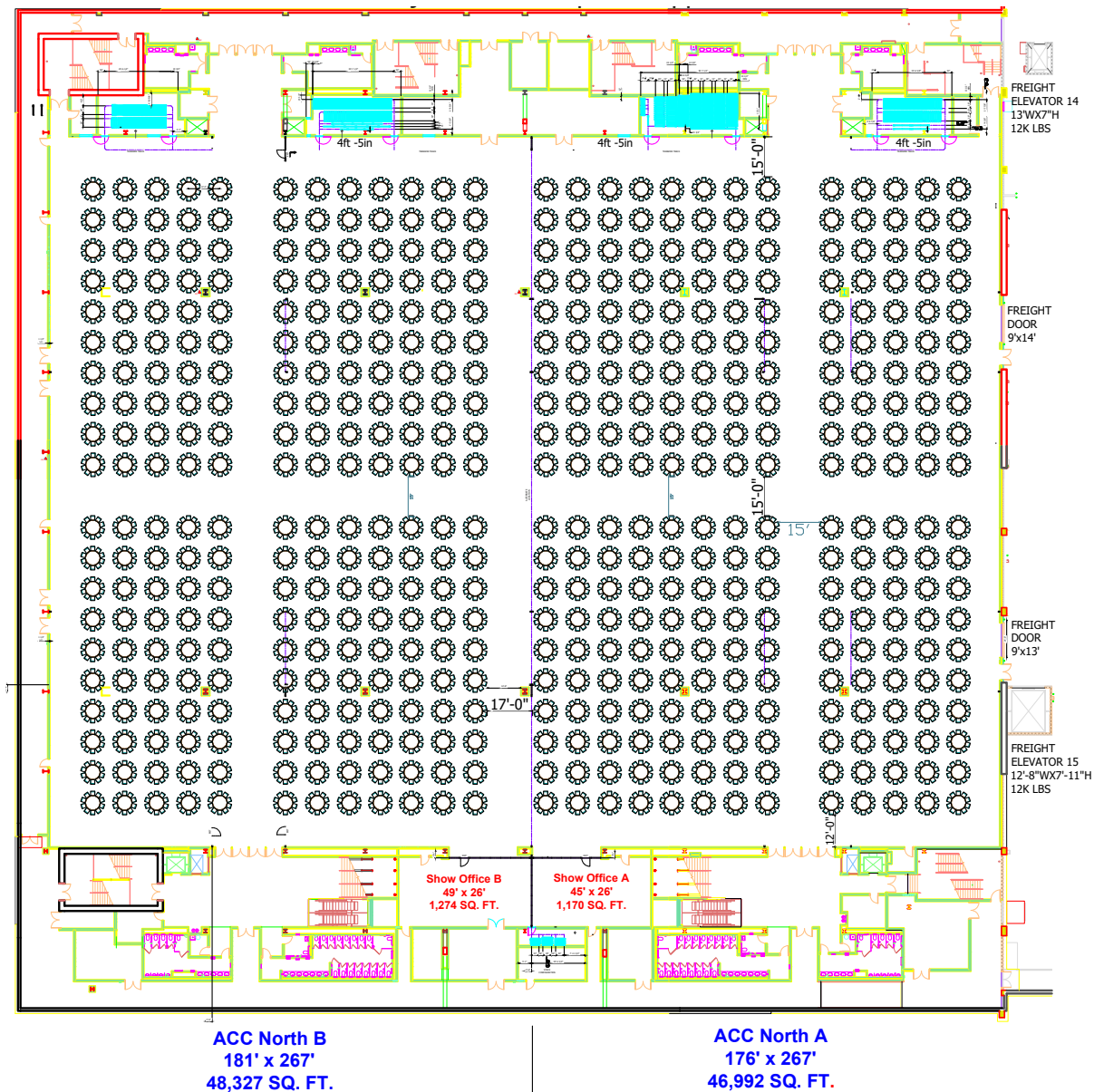
