

The Arts

Enjoy a performance at Segerstrom Center for the Arts, one of the largest arts complexes in the U.S. designed by renowned architect Cesar Pelli, the venue is noted for its architecturally distinctive sweeping curved glass facade. The lobby ceiling is an art installation called Constellation. It is finished in silver leaf with Swarovski crystal LED lights and 300 individually suspended pendants of polished stainless steel tipped with faceted Baccarat crystal globes.

The venue showcases significant national and international productions of music, dance and theater by top theater companies and legendary artists. Or take in a play at the Tony[®] Award-winning South Coast Repertory, a regional theatre offering world premieres and theatrical favorites.
