Annapolis Welcomes Spring Sailboat Show April 28-30 City Dock Parking Restrictions Begin Midnight on April 25

Annapolis (April 5, 2023) - The Annapolis Spring Sailboat Show is back at City Dock and will run from 10 a.m. on Friday, April 28 to 5 p.m. on Sunday, April 30 at City Dock in downtown Annapolis. Thousands of visitors will be in downtown Annapolis to see new and brokerage sailboats for sale along with exhibitors, seminars and vendors. In addition to boarding beautiful sailboats, guests are invited to meet with boating clubs and charters companies, shop gear and equipment, and catch up with marine professionals and sailing friends alike.

Cars will not be permitted to park at the end of Dock Street (from the Harbormaster's Office to Susan Campbell Park) beginning at midnight on April 25. Cars that remain after that time will be removed. Dock Street and Prince George Street from Craig Street to the water will be closed to vehicles and used for show setup.

Boats will have limited dockage in Ego Alley after Sunday, April 23. Pay attention to red mooring bags and no docking signs. As always, visitors must check in with the Harbormaster (410-263-7973 or VHF 17).

Vendor load-ins will begin on April 25 for water exhibits and April 27 for land exhibits.

PARKING:

Visitors can pay to park at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium and Eastport Elementary School. There is a free shuttle to the show from Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. Eastport Elementary is a short walk across the Spa Creek bridge.

City Garages: Park at any one of the regular city garages: Knighton, Gotts Court, or Park Place and take the Free Downtown "Magenta" Shuttle. Hillman Garage remains closed for reconstruction.

Online Pre-Paid Parking Option: Visitors can reserve parking in advance at Gotts (25 Calvert Street, \$16.80 per day), or Knighton (1a Colonial Ave. at \$11.20 per day) garages. For details, visit www.AnnapolisParking.com.

Additional Garages: Visitors may also find free parking at the State-owned Garage (aka Calvert Street Garage) at 19 St. Johns Street after 6 pm, Monday-Friday and all weekend. Whitmore Garage located at 25 Clay Street is also available to the public as space allows for

a fee after 9 a.m. Monday through Saturday. Whitmore is free to the public every Sunday until 4 pm.
