THINGS TO KNOW



Q: What Health Precautions Are Being Taken?

A: The measures we have implemented include:

- Health screening area provided for client at entries for us at their discretion
- Hand washing stations positioned throughout the concourse
- No bag policy to minimize person-to-person contact
- Ticket scanning pedestals utilized to minimize person-to-person contact
- Cashless transactions (parking, concessions, box office)
- Guests are required to wear a face covering inside the building
- Guests will be asked to follow social distancing guidelines when using the restroom facilities
- Guests are discouraged from congregating inside or outside of Globe Life Field or its surrounding areas (including the parking lots).

Q. What Health Precautions Should I Take BEFORE My Visit?

A: Public health authorities recommend self-screening before you enter public places, and not entering public places with any of the following signs or symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

Q. What Health Precautions Should I Take DURING My Visit?

A: Currently, the CDC and DSHS recommend practicing the following protocols which are subject to change:

- Wear a face covering in public
- Wait 6 feet from others not within the same household
- Wash hands often for 20 seconds
- If no soap and water are available, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw the tissue away

THINGS TO KNOW

Q: What Health Precautions Are Being Taken?

A: The measures we have implemented include:

- Reduced entrances
- Temperature screenings prior to entry for all employees
- Physical distancing practices including physically-distanced queues and barriers
- Temporary operation modifications, including reduced hours at select locations
- Increased focus on disinfection and sanitation in high-traffic areas such as elevators, handrails, benches, tables, handles, restrooms
- New hand-washing stations and hand sanitizers in key areas
- Disposable silverware and glassware
- Cashless & Contactless payments encouraged (i.e. credit cards, debit cards, & mobile wallets)

Q: What Parking Options Are Available?

A: During this initial phase, Guests will be directed to self-park; valet will not be available.

Q: Do I Need To Wear A Face Covering?

A: All Guests ages 10 and older are required to wear face coverings when visiting Texas Live!

All Face Coverings Should:

- Fully cover your nose and mouth and allow you to remain hands-free
- Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- Be secured with ties or ear loops
- Be made of breathable material, either disposable or reusable
- Costume masks are not considered appropriate and are prohibited from being worn

You are encouraged to wear face coverings at all times, except while dining. The use of face coverings are not a substitute for physical distancing. Remember to bring your mask before you leave! Guests must provide their own disposable or reusable face covering.
