### March 2018 Financial Statements

Danette Snopek reported 64 event days versus a budget of 68. In the convention center, one banquet occurred versus eight budgeted and fourteen meetings versus fifteen budgeted. The Central IL RV Show exceeded budget. The Alpaca Owners Association convention was new event and attendance was over budget by 6,800. The IHSA boys basketball tournament resulted in 3,300 less attendees than budget. IHSA Drama exceeded attendees by 3,300 and was over budget. There were two concerts in the arena, Winter Jam and Gary Allen. Gary Allen was not budgeted. In the theater we had three concerts. Get the Led Out exceeded budget to a sold out show. Earth Wind & Fire and Peter Frampton both exceeded budget. Luxury Box income is under budget due to one vacant suite.

Wages/benefits were under budget for the month while utilities and snow removal were

over budget. The HRA to the Peoria Civic Center was over budget by \$147,119. The re-projected operating loss for the fiscal year is \$699,081. There was a discussion on the new stormwater utility tax and how it will affect the Peoria Civic Center.
