ABOUT DAVID F. COUCH BALLPARK

David F. Couch Ballpark has been a home for baseball for Wake Forest University and Winston-Salem since it opened in 1956.

The ballpark, which seats 3,823 fans, is part of the Wake Forest athletics facilities complex that also includes LJVM Coliseum and Allegacy Stadium. The complex is located less than three miles north of downtown Winston-Salem and one mile south of the Wake Forest campus.

In 2016, the park was named in honor of former Wake Forest baseball player David Couch, who made the lead gift for construction of a \$14 million Player Development Center, which opened the following year.

During the summer months, the Carolina Disco Turkeys, one of the best and most popular college woodbat teams in the Southeast, take up the field for their team home games.
