You'll discover stories such as where Duke Ellington played in the early 20th century, how the Last Resort got its name and all the moves of the fabulous 40 Watt Club. You'll also find sites where famous music videos were filmed and album photography was shot, like the Murmur Trestle. Download the self-guided tour from VisitAthensGA.com/music-tour or pick up a copy at the Athens Welcome Center or the Athens Convention & Visitors Bureau (p. 4).

Don't miss the **UGA Special Collections** galleries for interactive exhibits, including broadcast media and music.

Seek out favorite and hard-to-find albums and local band tees at **Wuxtry Records**, where members of R.E.M. first met and going strong as "One of the South's Best Musical Landmarks" (*Southern Living*, March 2018.) You'll find more albums and music memorabilia at **Lo You Stuff** and **Atomic Athens**. Score some hot new threads along Clayton Street's boutiques and more vintage shops on Jackson Street.

CRAFT BEER

Athens is becoming known around the Southeast as a beer destination, complete with great breweries and pubs. Spend happy hour at the source of good times and good beer, with a tour, tastings and live music.

GET COMFORTABLE



Terrapin Beer Co., Athens' first brewery, paved the way for other local breweries as Georgia's legislation became more friendly to the brewing industry. Terrapin's original Rye Pale Ale is still a best-seller, joined by plenty of other year-round offerings such as Hopsecutioner, an IPA with hints of pine and citrus flavors, plus special seasonal releases such as Pumpkinfest in the fall, Moo Hoo Chocolate Stout in winter and Watermelon Gose in the summer.

Creature Comforts Brewing Company's Tropicalia IPA and Athena beers have become a sensation, from their recent appearance in the new *Avengers: Endgame* movie. Known for its superior sours such as Athena, Creature Comforts also brews a full line of year-round and seasonal releases. An expanded tasting room and patio area sweeten the visitor experience.

Southern Brewing Company made its mark with a wild yeast program. Through a collaboration with the UGA Microbiology Department, Southern isolates wild yeast strains to use in their brews such as the Wild Azalea and Cherokee Rose. Fewer than 50 breweries in the United States are running a similar yeast program.

Akademia Brewing Company has brought craft beer to Athens' West Corridor, with an emphasis on food-beer pairings at the brewpub. Even the sauces are beer-based! Akademia specializes in sour beers, as well as serving traditional German styles with a flavorful twist.

Athentic Brewing Company is set to open in fall 2019 in the heart of Athens' Normaltown neighborhood. Authentic plans to focus on small batch handcrafted beers that are both unique and easy drinking. The centerpiece of the tasting room will be the self-serve beer wall with 12 taps of Authentic Beer allowing customers to pour by the ounce without standing in long lines.

HAPPY HOUR COCKTAILS



THE EXPAT Jerry Slater literally wrote the book on cocktails, *The Southern Foodways Alliance Guide to Cocktails*. Try his signature, with Maurin Quina, Junipero gin and a touch of Luxardo Maraschino liqueur. In Five Points. Named one of the South's Best New Bars by *Garden and Gun*.



THE WORLD FAMOUS This unassuming downtown spot does it all well: drink menu with alcoholic and non-alcoholic creations, tasty food and live music. Named one of *Esquire* magazine's "Best Bars in America."



THE GLOBE A downtown staple since 1989, The Globe is an Irish-style pub that's a welcoming spot for professors, students, professionals and visitors. Named one of *Esquire* magazine's "Best Bars in America."



THE OLD PAL The neighborhood bar in Normaltown offers seasonal cocktails, craft beers and Old World wines along with a well-rounded list of whiskey and amari. The Old Pal has been named one of the "South's Best Bars" by *Southern Living* magazine.

Classic City Beer Festival, each April, has been named one of the 25 Best Beer Festivals in the World by UpRoxx.

DINING DISCOVERIES

Athens' chefs have been inspired by the town's creative energy to develop a happening food scene full of discoveries. It will take more than one Athens getaway to sample all of the delectable food & drink options, but there's no better time to get started.



BREAKFAST

Athenians take their coffee seriously, and you can head to the source by visiting **Jittery Joe's Coffee Roaster** on Barber Street or its several coffee shops around town. **1000 Faces Coffee** in downtown Athens also roasts its own beans onsite and supplies many of Athens' top restaurants. For those who like hearty fare to start the day, Athens delivers. Super-sized biscuits at **Mama's Boy** and omelet specials at **The Grit** are local favorites. Prefer a continental breakfast? Stop by **Independent Baking Company** in Five Points for hearth-baked breads and pastries, from scratch daily, or **Ike & Jane** in Normaltown for crazy-good donuts.

LUNCH

Athens insiders know to venture off the beaten path and into historic neighborhoods for lunch. **Pulaski Heights BBQ** smokes meats daily and prepares inventive sides from scratch including squash casserole, smoked cauliflower, and kimchi. Chef-owner Chuck Ramsey provides plenty of vegetarian, vegan, and gluten-free options. **White Tiger Gourmet** makes its home in a 100-plus-year-old former grocery store and serves fresh selections made from local and organic products. Specialty sandwiches include vegetarian ciabatta and pecan-wood-smoked pulled pork or chicken. Another favorite lunch spot is **Heirloom Café**. Housed in a former gas station, its mission is to create community, celebrate local farmers, and tell stories through food. Each of these spots is also open for dinner and has lovely patio seating. Finally, no visit to Athens is complete without checking out **Weaver D's**, whose slogan, Automatic for the People, became the title of one of R.E.M.'s best-selling albums (and still serves some pretty fine soul food, to boot!)



DINNER

At **Five & Ten**, Chef-Owner Hugh Acheson and Chef de Cuisine Telly Mazzio continue to serve new interpretations of Southern cuisine melded with French and Italian influences. Fans of James Beard Award-winner Acheson will also want to dine with other chefs—including the aforementioned Chuck Ramsey—who came up through the Five & Ten kitchen. Peter Dale has gone on to great success with **The National**, which celebrates southern Mediterranean cuisine through a southern U.S. lens. Dale has also opened **Maepole** and **Seabear Oyster Bar**, which offers a casual vibe and a menu of delectable oysters—plus surprising weekly specials such as Ramen Monday and Tiki Taco Tuesday. Shae and Ryan Sims fell in love while working at Five & Ten and have gone on to open **Donna Chang's**, a small neighborhood restaurant offering a casual-yet-refined take on Chinese-American fare. Mimi Maumus at **home.made** looks to her roots in New Orleans as well as her decades in Georgia for inspiration in dishes such as tomato pie, shrimp and grits, and New Orleans hot chicken.

DAY 1
LATE AFTERNOON: Unwind and de-stress. You’re in Athens, and happy hour awaits! Head to one of Athens’ **craft breweries** for a tour and tasting. Go up to the **Georgia Theatre** rooftop for an unbeatable view of downtown, or to the **Globe**, **Seabear** or **The Old Pal** for a top-notch craft cocktail. (p. 9)
DINNER: Indulge with choices from casual to refined fare. (p. 11)
EVENING: Experience Athens’ renowned live music scene! (p. 6)

DAY 2
BREAKFAST: Savor fresh-roasted coffee at **1000 Faces** or **Jittery Joe’s** coffee roasters, and enjoy a hearty breakfast at **Mama’s Boy**, **Big City Bread** or **The Grit**.
MORNING EXPLORING: Head across Broad St. to UGA’s historic **North Campus**, the birthplace of public higher education in America. Then, hit the trails at the **State Botanical Garden of Georgia** or the **Oconee Rivers Greenway**.
LUNCH: You can’t go wrong with any of the #AthensGaEats choices.
AFTERNOON: Enjoy the galleries at the **Georgia Museum of Art**. Check out **Lyndon House Arts Center** for current art exhibits plus the **Ware-Lyndon** historic house museum. Browse through downtown Athens’ vast collection of vintage stores, record shops and local boutiques.
EVENING: There’s more good food, craft beer, and live music to be had! Or, take in a performance at **The Classic Center**, the **UGA Performing Arts Center** or by a local theatre company.

DAY 3
Venture just a few blocks from Downtown to discover:
FIVE POINTS: This Victorian neighborhood houses antique shops, **Avid Book Shop** and **Condor Chocolates**, an Ecuadorian bean-to-bar chocolatier.
BOULEVARD: Founded as a streetcar suburb in the late 19th century, this neighborhood’s contemporary art is found within rustic exteriors. Avid Book Shop’s first location is here, along with yummy restaurants.
NORMALTOWN: Named for the former State Normal School for teacher education, this neighborhood is experiencing a renaissance as home to UGA’s Health Sciences campus, with amenities from coffee shops to cocktail bars.

Don’t forget to grab a last, memorable meal and an authentic piece of Athens to take home with you, such as local artwork, UGA fan gear or a six-pack or growler of craft beer.

ARTISTRY

Art is around every corner in Athens, from public art installations to the state's official art museum, from local galleries to shops filled with artisan fare, and from the bright lights of The Classic Center and UGA Performing Arts Center stages to several local theatre groups.

Explore the **Georgia Museum of Art's** permanent collection, with strengths in American painting and Southern decorative arts, plus exhibitions from around the world. Take time to visit the well-curated gift shop and stop for coffee at the cafe. Cross the plaza to the **Lamar Dodd School of Art** to see what UGA students and faculty are creating.

The large, airy galleries of the **Lyndon House Arts Center** are a revelation, nestled downtown behind one of Athens' historic house museums. Local and regional artist exhibitions are featured, in addition to a gallery shop stocked with works in a variety of media.

Head to the **Chase Street Warehouse District** for high-flying trapeze performance art at **Canopy Studio**. **Frog Stomp Studio**, a children's open art studio that nurtures creative play, is a family favorite (as are the

monthly Family Day Saturday programs at Georgia Museum of Art.) Nearby you'll find **ATHICA: Athens Institute for Contemporary Art**.

Athens performing arts are exceptional. Headliner entertainers, touring Broadway productions, and top comedians grace **The Classic Center Theatre** stage. **UGA's Performing Arts Center** showcases the finest music, dance, and theatre performers from around the world. Athens is also the proud home of several local theatre companies, including **Town and Gown Players**, **Rose of Athens**, **Athens Community Theatre**, and **Circle Ensemble Theatre Company**. Be sure to look up performance schedules for the dates of your visit to Athens!

HOME & GARDEN

Cross over Broad Street in downtown Athens and venture back two centuries to the birthplace of public higher education in America, the University of Georgia. Get a glimpse into the lives and legacy of antebellum Athens as you tour historic house museums and their authentic gardens.

Athens' four **historic house museums** represent distinct architectural styles from different decades of the 19th century. Download a self-guided tour brochure, pick one up at the Athens Welcome Center or Convention & Visitors Bureau, or make a reservation for a guided tour with **Classic City Tours**. Choose the Athens Heritage Tour – a 90-minute driving tour of historic districts and landmarks – or the **Museum Mile** – a two-hour tour of all four antebellum interiors. Don't miss seeing the authentic period gardens at each house museum!

Take a stroll through historic **North Campus**, which is modeled after Yale University and is the setting of some of the oldest buildings in Athens, dating back to the start of classes in 1801.

Georgia's history comes to life at the **University of Georgia's Special Collections** building. Historic and cultural treasures are on display, including interactive exhibits, Georgia artifacts and even a full-sized replica of Senator Richard B. Russell's Washington office. Audiovisual displays include the Peabody Award collection and vintage town films.

ATHENS: BIRTHPLACE OF AMERICA'S FIRST GARDEN CLUB

Explore the gardens and five miles of trails at the 313-acre preserve of the **State Botanical Garden of Georgia**. A stunning tropical conservatory is surrounded by themed gardens showcasing native and international flora. The grounds also include the **Garden Club of Georgia State Headquarters** and the lovely **Day Chapel**. Bring your binoculars: the Garden is an Audubon-designated Important Bird Area. Grab a refreshment at the garden's cafe' and stop in one of Athens' best gift shops, featuring a wide range of local products, including honey made from the garden's bee hives.

Another must-see attraction for green thumbs is the **Trial Gardens at UGA**. See horticulturists in action as they determine the "best of the best" plants for our region's heat and humidity.

SPORTS & REC

Athens more than doubles its population on home football weekends with a tailgate scene that can't be beat! UGA sports action goes on far beyond the gridiron, and, best of all, admission to many UGA sports events is FREE! Get in on the fun with a walk (or hike, or climb, or kayak) that's a bit off the beaten path.



Start out where it all began. **Herty Field**, on historic North Campus, is the site of early Bulldog football games played under Pop Warner in the 1890s. It's a far cry from **Sanford Stadium** just a few blocks away, which seats 92,746 fans and is the nation's tenth-largest stadium in the NCAA. Here on gameday? Enjoy Dawg Walk, approximately two hours before kickoff.

Recapture the best moments from UGA sports history at **Butts-Mehre Heritage Hall**, which features memorabilia and interactive displays. You'll see the 1980 national championship football trophy and Heisman trophies won by Frank Sinkwich and Herschel Walker, plus exhibits from the 1996 Atlanta Olympics sports held in Athens. UGA is also home to the ITF Men's Collegiate Tennis Hall of Fame.

Cyclists will find new trails to love in Athens: The first sections of the rails-to-trail **Firefly Trail** have opened, with the trailhead right in downtown crossing over the Middle Oconee River. **Trail Creek Park** is the site of a new, professionally designed mountain bike trail. Don't feel like traveling with your bike? No worries! Stay at Graduate Athens or Hotel Indigo and borrow one of theirs! Or, get a rental from Hub Bicycles, which also offers no-drop rides each morning.

Sandy Creek Park surrounds the 260-acre Lake Chapman and features picnic sites, swimming, play-

grounds, fishing, dog runs, disc golf course and a 7-mile lakeside trail for hikers or adventurous joggers.

Continue your outdoor exploration at the **North Oconee River Greenway**, a linear park open sunrise to sunset for all types of non-motorized uses, including dogs on leashes. An added Greenway treat: Over 50 interpretive heritage markers are placed along a half-mile stretch by Dudley Park. Enjoy the beauty of the Middle Oconee River with a kayak trip from **Big Dogs on the River**, or put in your own kayak or canoe at **Ben Burton Park**.

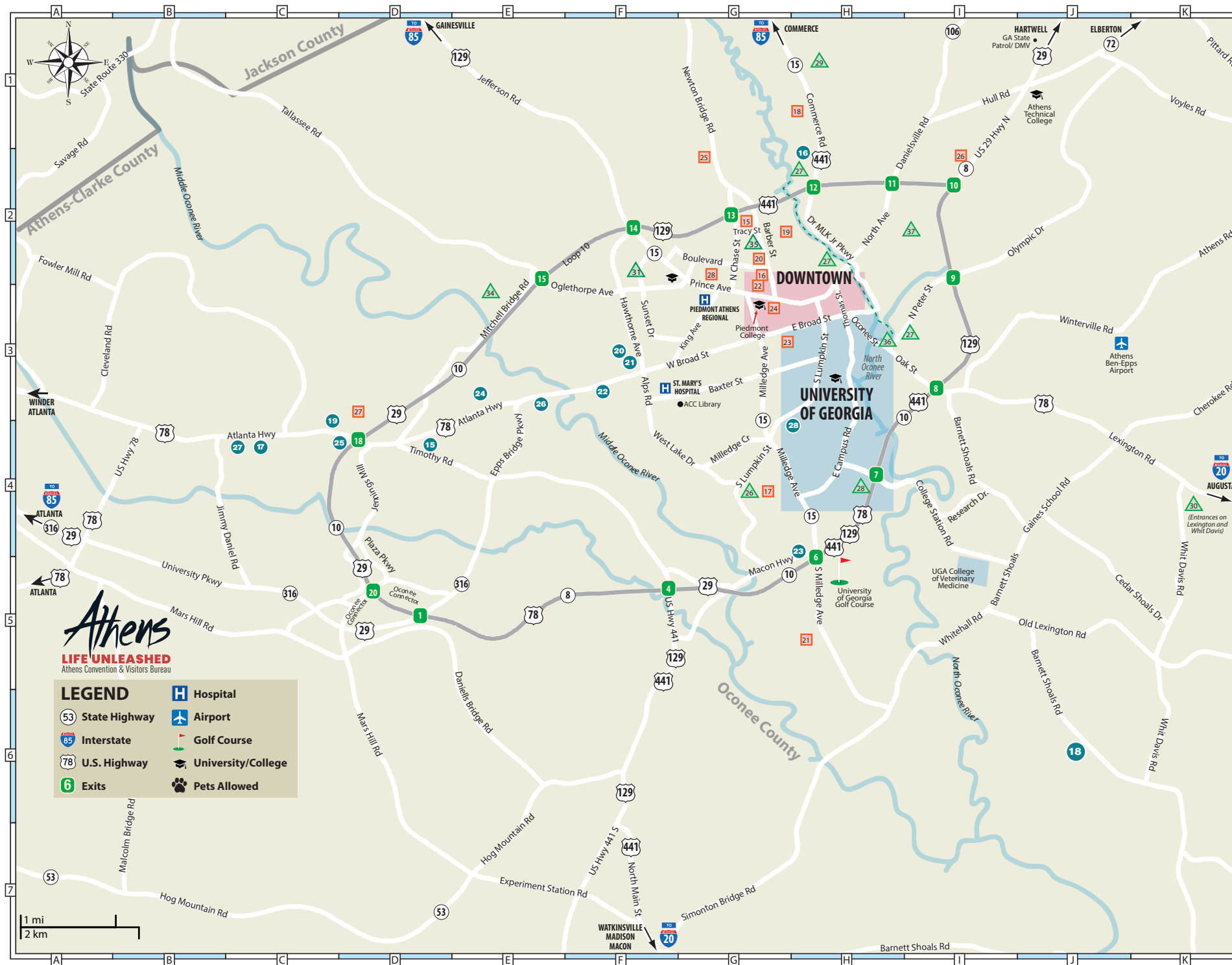
Golfers will want to play one the best campus golf courses in America, the Robert Trent Jones Sr.- designed **UGA Golf Course**.

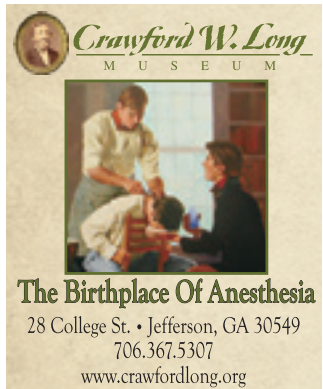

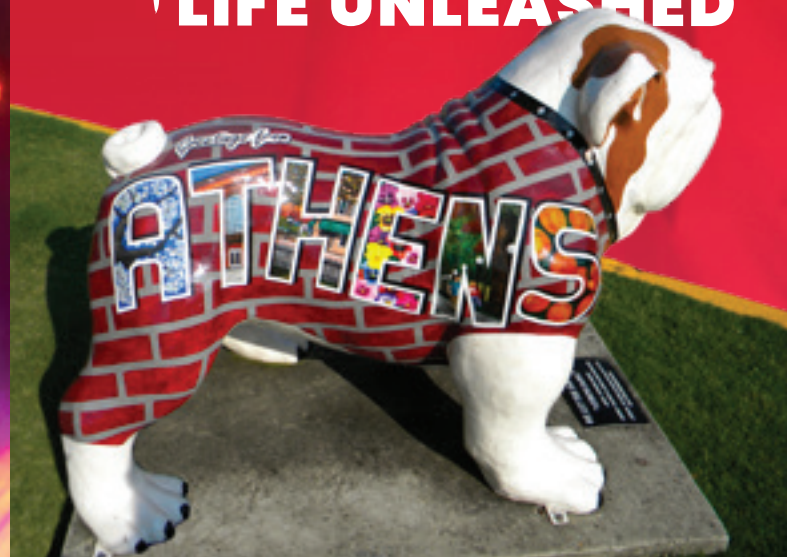
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
