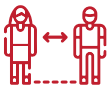

Ready.



Establish and follow approved protocol.

Set.



Follow CDC standards for sanitizing and disinfecting.



Train employees on protocol to reduce the spread.

Go Safely.



Wear cloth face coverings and maintain 6-feet of distance.



Welcome patrons who are following guidelines.

As you start to venture out, we ask that you commit to go safely:



Limit close contact and maintain 6-feet of distance.



Avoid large gatherings.



Wear cloth face coverings in public.



Wash hands or use hand sanitizer.



Clean and disinfect personal items and surfaces.



Respect people and guidelines.
