- All six stamps must be visible to win. Take notes in the back of this guide to document your travels.

Akademia opened its doors on the cusp of changes to the direct-to-consumer sales laws in Georgia in 2017. The owners decided that opening as a brew pub would allow them to be multidimensional and serve delicious food to beer-loving patrons.

AN OVERVIEW OF BEER STYLES

Lager

Crisp, clean, and refreshing. Often lighter in color and higher in carbonation. Brewed and fermented slowly in low temperatures.

Ale

Hoppy, aromatic, and more intense. Often darker in color and higher in ABV. Brewed and fermented quickly in higher temperatures.

India Pale Ale

AKA the IPA. A hoppier version of the larger ale category. Became famous in the early 19th century for strong hoppy flavors and high ABV. Now your beer snob buddy's favorite brew.

Pilsner

Type of lager with a strong hop flavor and rooted in the tradition of Czech brewers.

Served in a tall, taped at the bottom glass.

Sour

Intentionally acidic, tart, or sour in taste.

Traditional sour beer styles include Belgian lambics, Berliner Weisse, gueuze and Flanders red ale, and goses.

Stout

Dark, top-fermented beer type with a number of varieties. The first known use of the word stout for beer, in a 1677 document, referred to its strength and potency.

BEER the Athens Way

thentic Brewing is the second of two breweries to open in 2020. Opening in late August, Athentic has operated as a melting pot and meeting point for all Athenians. From drag and dog meetups to hip hop shows and fly fish lure tying, Athentic has something for everyone both indoors and outside on the patio. Just be sure to check out Athentic's impressive lineup of beers, seltzers, slushies, and more!


Like other Athens breweries, Athentic has a rich homebrewing tradition, including winning the People's choice award at the Athens Homebrew festival which spurred their first commercial beer batch with Akademia, Bold Faced Rye.

THE GLASS MAKES THE BEER



Pilsner

Tall and tapered at the end. Best for pilsners, pale lagers, and pale ales. Showcases clarity and enhances aroma.



Tulip

Tulip bulb shaped body and flared lip. Ideal for Belgian ales as the bowl traps the aroma, and the stem allows for a good swirl.



Snifter

Best for heavy IPAs and Belgian ales, the wide bowl is used for swirling, while the tapered mouth is for aroma.



Weizen

The glass is narrow at the bottom and slightly wider at the top to release aroma and providing room for the often thick, fluffy heads.



Imperial Pint

Classic shape with bulge near the lip. A staple in English pubs. The unique shape adds to the overall durability, and fits well in the hand.



Pint

The old faithful. Great for holding a large pour of your favorite beer.

ormaltown Brewing was one of two breweries that opened their doors in 2020. Starting up in February, Normaltown has already been gaining buzz around town and in the area for their fresh take on small-batch IPAs. Currently, the only way to get a taste of Normaltown brews is to visit the brewery and taproom, making this a spot you don't want to miss!

The Normaltown team secured its location from a Craigslist ad in November 2017, finding an intimate space that was exactly what the founders envisioned for the brewery.

A HISTORY OF ATHENS IN 6 BEERS

nderstanding the history of Athens brewing means understanding the welcoming community and passionate folks who helped pave the way and turn Athens into the All-American Beer Town. The biggest supporter among them? To the Athens brewers it's simple: Sachin Patel.

Sachin has been the nexus for Athens brewers since the early 2000s. His bottle shop served as the biggest taproom in town, and today each brewery in town has a connection to Sachin and his guidance. Without Sachin, we may not have the beer haven we know and love today.

As the first Athens brewery, **Terrapin Beer Co.** helped pave the way and change the cultural and legal hurdles for the breweries that followed, like clearing the 6% law that mandated all beers brewed be under 6% ABV. Terrapin put Athens on the map with their award-winning **Terrapin Rye Ale**, and Athens hasn't looked back since.

Creature Comforts opened in the heart of downtown in 2014 and quickly established itself as a major player in the craft beer industry. Their

Tropicália IPA has risen to the top of many best beer lists and further cemented Athens as a premier beer town. Be on the lookout for their new taproom coming to Los Angeles.

Southern Brewing Co. opened in 2015 as the first purpose-built brewery in Georgia, located just a couple miles from downtown and is nestled within 15-acres of land. This company embodies the unique combination that makes Athens so special, much like their **Red & Black Fruited Berliner Weisse.**

Akademia Brewing opened in 2017 and is now Athens's sole brewpub. Located just off Atlanta Highway, Akademia combines their rustic and industrial charm with gourmet food and uniquely crafted brews, like their **IQ IPA**. They are dedicated to crafting a full dining and beer experience for all patrons.

Normaltown Brewing and Athentic Brewing both opened in 2020 just outside of downtown in two of Athens' historic neighborhoods: Normaltown and Boulevard, respectively. As the most recent additions to the Athens beer scene both breweries have gained serious attention for their eclectic spins on beer classics, like Normaltown's Summon the Fog NEIPA and Athentic's Rapid Recovery Blonde Ale.



ounded in 2002, Terrapin is the oldest craft brewery in Athens. During that same year their Rye Pale Ale won a Gold Medal at the Great American Beer Festival in Denver and put Athens on the map. They have been continuously brewing from their current location since 2007, ushering in a whole new era for the Athens beer community, and from there, the rest was history. Now you can find Hopsecutioner IPA and other Terrapin brews around the country.



Raise a Glass

Terrapin became the first craft brewery in Georgia to produce solar brewed beer with its solar panel array on the brewery's roof, all part of its 'Terraprint' initiative, focusing on minimizing its impact on the environment and maximizing impact on community.
