Prior to COVID-related closures and restrictions, FILM Augusta was on track for an even stronger year than 2019. Interest in Augusta has not stopped, as indicated in the below graphic. Though we had to halt additional location tours, we have received more registrations and inquiries year over year.

In a collaboration with Film Columbia County, we hosted a tour of Augusta's River Region film locations for members of the Location Managers Guild International (LMGI) the first weekend of March. Eight industry professionals attended and were able to take photos and gain knowledge of local film-friendly locations. Several inquiries were made for locations as a result and once the film industry hold lifts, we anticipate both short- and long-term return on investment of new productions in our area. 
