#### FILM AUGUSTA ADVISORY PANEL FORMED:

In July, the Film Augusta Advisory Panel was formed to act as a supporting organization to FILM Augusta, providing insight and advice to grow the film industry in Augusta. The first meeting of the FILM Augusta Advisory Panel included local film industry stakeholders: Nick Laws, President of <u>Southeastern Filmmakers</u>, Krys Bailey, of Le Chat Noir's <u>BlackCat Picture Show</u> film festival, and Terrence Williams, from <u>Indiegrip</u>. Other confirmed members are Daniel Sol, <u>HollyShorts Film Festival</u>, and entertainment attorney <u>Sincerai D. Stallings</u>.

*"I'm glad to be serving on the Film Augusta Advisory Panel. When we all work together, everyone benefits,"* said Terrence Williams of Indiegrip.

The Film Augusta Advisory Panel will meet on a regular basis to be determined to offer guidance and confirmation of Film Augusta's efforts.

Note: In 2018, FILM Augusta assisted with eight projects total. At mid-year, growth of incoming productions is apparent.

#### FILM AUGUSTA JOINS SPONSORS OF MAJOR SHORT FILM FESTIVAL:




#### The HollyShorts Film Festival
