













Batavia






Plano

Sugar Grove



The Fox River itself is a natural playground for thousands of visitors each year - designated a National Water Trail by the National Park Service, the Fabulous Fox Water Trail welcomes all to paddle downstream and experience the natural beauty of the Aurora Area. The river snakes through Silver Springs State Fish and Wildlife Area, a picture sque area centered around a pool of clear, bubbling water that never freezes - even in extreme cold. At Fermilab Natural Areas, an ecosystem rich in biodiversity is open and free to access for visitors year-round. Enjoy more than 6,800 acres of pristine prairie with herds of bison, hike beautiful trails – or cross-country ski in the winter - and catch a glimpse of 300 species of migratory birds. Red Oak Nature Center. located on the east bank of the Fox River, surrounded by 40 acres of forested

wildlife habitat, is a fantastic place for visitors to learn about the Northern Illinois outdoors.

Just west of Yorkville, the 400-acre Hoover Forest

Preserve features a breathtaking assortment of natural wonders, including oak-wooded bluffs, plunging ravines, and babbling creeks feeding into the Fox River, plus more than 300 species of native plants. On the banks of the Fox River between Geneva and Batavia, Fabyan Forest Preserve provides miles of trails for hiking and biking in addition to boat and kayak access. The preserve is also home to the Fabyan Windmill — a 68-story structure built by a German craftsman around 1850 — and the Fabyan Villa Museum, home to George and Nelly Fabyan until 1939 and redesigned by famed architect Frank Lloyd Wright in 1907. Visitors to the Fabyan Forest Preserve will also discover the Japanese

Tea Garden, a private garden designed by Taro Otsuka that provides a serene setting for special events and photography sessions. Situated on a stratified gravel hill known as a kame, the heavily wooded Johnson's Mound Preserve southeast of Elburn offers shaded trails for a quiet getaway as well as a recreational area for get-togethers and a sledding hill in winter. The 385-acre Peck Farm Park has miles of paved and natural trails for hikers, bikers, and rollerbladers, in addition to a 19-acre wetland, sensory gardens, and the Butterfly House, featuring hundreds of non-native butterflies.

The Aurora Area portion of the **Fox River Trail** connects the communities of Geneva, Batavia, North Aurora, Aurora, Montgomery, and Oswego. Occupying more than 130 acres of the Fox River shoreline, the winding trails at **Saw Wee Kee Park** are a popular destination

for off-road cycling, trail running, and horseback riding. Pedal or hike the beautiful, 12-mile **Virgil L. Gilman Trail**, which connects the Fox River Trail to the western communities of the Aurora Area, as well as the wooded campus of Waubonsee Community College in Sugar Grove.

The Aurora Area's green spaces also provide plenty of opportunities to kick back and relax — or play with the family. Located on more than 325 acres, the crown jewel of Aurora's public parks, **Phillips Park**, offers a variety of fun amenities for all ages and interests, including the Sunken Gardens, the Phillips Park Zoo, the Phillips Park Golf Course, the Family Aquatic Center, the Mastodon Trail/Boat Dock, a dog park, sand volleyball, and a BMX/ skate park.

FOX RIVER Valley 7

Several communities of the Aurora Area share a connection to the Fox River. As a primary travel route for Native Americans and early settlers, the Fox River Valley region flourished in the early 1800s. Numerous trading posts and settlements began to pop up, eventually growing into the towns and cities we know today. Designated as a National Water Trail by the U.S. Department of the Interior, the Fox River provides innumerable recreational opportunities, from kayaking treks to fishing expeditions. Whether you choose an adventure on the river itself, enjoy it from the shores, or venture further to more rural areas, the Fox River Valley provides a natural draw and beautiful backdrop for your next getaway.

Diverse scenery includes an old trestle bridge. Portage at Montgomery and enjoy downtown dining. Disembark at Hudson Crossing Park.

Oswego – Yorkville

6.3 MILES

A shallow beach at Oswego's Hudson Crossing Park allows for easy put-in. Paddle past Saw Wee Kee Park. Buoyed take-out is available above Marge Cline Whitewater Course. Enjoy views of the Fox River from the patio at Southbank Original Barbecue.
