


Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (AUS) is a state-of-the-art airport with 2 terminals, 37 gates, full customs facilities and 2 parallel runways, including a 12,250-foot runway. Easy to get to (only 7.5 miles from the Austin Convention Center) and easy to get through, passengers enjoy exceptional customer service Austin-style, with art exhibits and local food (from brisket and breakfast tacos to Shiner Bock beer) and 1,008 live music performances in 2022. In operation since 1999, the airport has roughly 260+ daily flights with nonstop service to over 95 destinations. A record 21 million passengers traveled through AUS in 2022 resulting in 55% growth from 2021.

AUS recently welcomed service to the following international destinations:

AUS recently expanded nonstop flight service from domestic destinations including:
