Artists from throughout the Midwest will gather for Bayfield's 60th annual Festival of Arts. This juried arts & crafts show is held in Memorial Park on the scenic shores of Lake Superior in downtown Bayfield. Events will include fine art vendors, local gallery tours and demonstrations. This is a juried show. A maximum total of 50 artists will be selected to display their work on the festival grounds.

The Festival of Arts kicks off Art Escape, a nine day celebraiton of "all things art" across Bayfield County and Madeline Island. Find out more about Art Escape on Bayfield.org.



IN CELEBRATION OF LAKE SUPERIOR!

In honor of Lake Superior, Bayfield Festival of Arts will highlight the artists who incorporate materials that are sourced directly

from the Big Lake. Those artists will be given a badge that says LAKE SUPERIOR SOURCED to display on their booth and will also be mentioned in the festival directory. Examples of materials that are LAKE SUPERIOR SOURCED include: Lake Superior agates, sea glass or basalt set in jewelry, painted or photographic images of Lake Superior, ceramics built with local clay.

FEES

- Jury fees: \$20 per category (non-refundable)
- Space fee for 10' X 10' booth: \$225
- Parking Fee: \$25 (optional)

BEST OF SHOW AWARDS

Three \$100 awards will be given on Saturday afternoon. Best of Show winners are invited to participate in the 2024 Festival of Arts, with guaranteed placement and at no additional charge.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Applicants are requested to submit four photos by email or mail.
 Please include three photos of the product/s to be sold and one photo of the booth/display. No photocopies.
- Applicants will be juried on three criteria: impact, creativity and marketability.
- Post-dated checks will not be accepted.
- Submit two checks: one for your jury fee and the other for your space fee. The jury fee will be cashed immediately; your space fee will be cashed once you have been juried and accepted into the festival.

CANCELLATIONS

If an applicant cancels their application prior to August 7, a full refund of space fees will be honored. For cancellations made after August 7 but prior to August 14, half of the booth fee will be refunded. After August 14, refunds will not be issued.

SPACE REQUESTS

- Returning artists may request their last year's space. Event organizers will do
 their best to assign a booth location as close to their previous space as possible
 but it is not guaranteed.
- It can be windy at times and canopy tents should be securely fastened into the ground.
- The responsibility of fitting into the space assigned is that of the exhibitor.
- Electrical outlets are not provided for any booths.

ARTISTS' REQUIREMENTS

- Mass produced, commercial or imported products are not allowed.
- Artists must be 18 years or older.
- All work displayed must be original and created by artist making the application.
- Artists must be present during all show hours:
 Saturday 10 AM to 5 PM and Sunday 10 AM to 4 PM.
- Booth space may be shared only if work presented is fully collaborative.
- Two artists creating two different types of work cannot share a booth.

ARTISTS' RESPONSIBILITIES

All vendors are required to have or to have applied for a Wisconsin Seller's Permit in order to participate. You can obtain one by contacting the WI Dept. of Revenue at (608) 266-2776 or by visiting the Wisconsin Department of revenue's website:

(ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES, CONTINUED)

- Artists must provide their own display materials and make accommodations in case of inclement weather.
- Displays must be set up by 10 AM on Saturday. Drop off and set up may take place beginning on Friday (September 8) morning, in Memorial Park.
 A dedicated unload area with artist parking available will be available at the base of Rittenhouse Ave., from 2pm until 9pm only.
- Please plan accordingly for any type of weather be it wind, rain, heat or sun. Weather can be unpredictable and exhibitors are encouraged to carry insurance for their artwork and displays.
 Stakes or weights are highly recommended.

PARKING

An area of parking has been reserved for artist parking two blocks from Memorial Park. Parking permit fee is \$25. Permits will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

LODGING: Once you receive notification that you have been accepted, you will need to reserve your lodging as soon as possible. Lodging availability can be found on our website at BAYFIELD.ORG.
