The following types of activities by individuals or organizations are allowed in the Bayfield Apple Festival:

- Distribution of literature or displaying signs on private property.
- Distribution of literature or displaying signs in vending booth with permit issued by Chamber.
- Distribution of literature or displaying signs on public property (without a booth space) including along parade route.

The Chamber of Commerce accepts Apple Festival applications and a \$175 fee from individuals and nonprofit organizations that seek a permit for a festival on-site space. This is the normal fee charged for all nonprofit organizations that wish to participate with booth space. As with all vendors, the Chamber reviews and approves or disapproves permit applications.

The Chamber of Commerce also accepts applications from individuals and nonprofit organizations that seek participation in the official Apple Festival parade.
