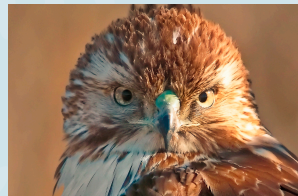
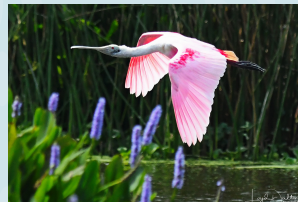
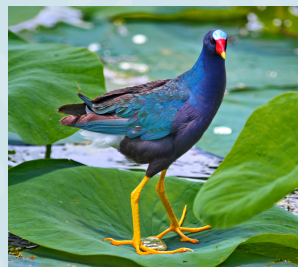
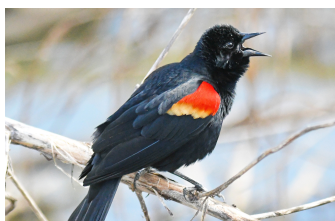
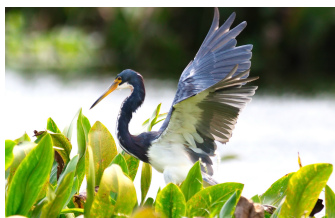


## Birdie Fun Fact!
