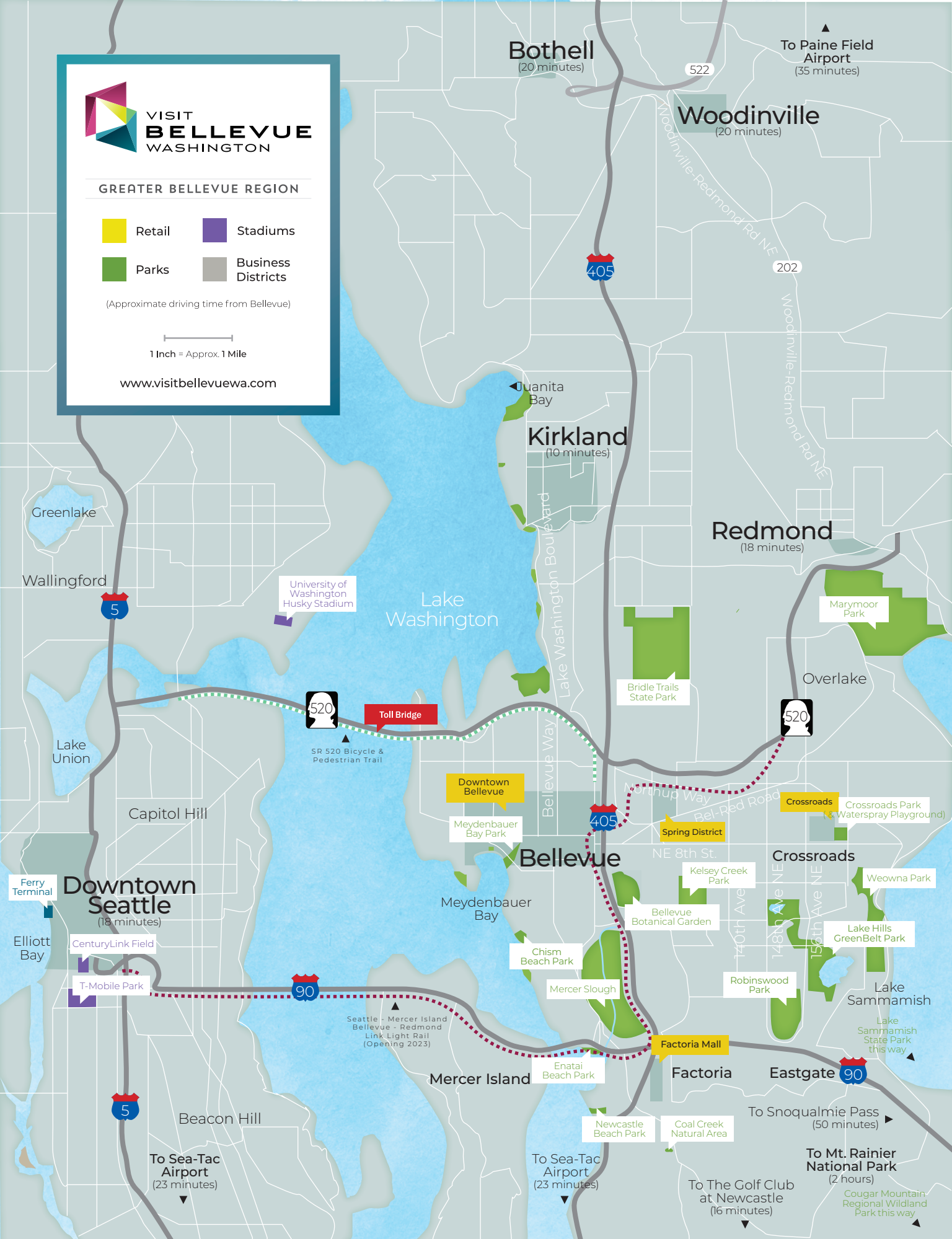

1 More than 140 of the state's 900-plus wineries, seven breweries, and four craft distilleries call Woodinville home.

3 Redmond's 640-acre Marymoor Park has a 40-acre off-leash area, a bird watching trail, the state's only velodrome, and access to the Burke-Gilman Trail and Sammamish Slough.

5 Picturesque Snoqualmie Falls is 30 minutes away, while hiking and skiing are within an hour east of Bellevue at Snoqualmie Pass.

2 Downtown Seattle, the Space Needle, and Pike Place Market are just 12 miles from Bellevues.

4 Kirkland, about five miles north of Bellevue on Lake Washington, teems with waterfront parks, boutiques, and restaurants.

6 Mount Rainier National Park, with two visitor centers, hiking, and snowshoeing, is roughly two hours south of downtown Bellevue.
