



Getting to Bellevue

Downtown Bellevue is conveniently accessible from Interstate 405 which runs north and south through Bellevue. In addition it is served by Interstate 90 to the south and State Route 520 to the north. Downtown Bellevue is just 10 miles east of downtown Seattle and 17 miles from Sea-Tac International Airport. The most convenient off-ramps from I-405 into downtown Bellevue are the NE 4th Street (Exit 13A) or NE 8th Street (Exit 13B). There is an HOV/Carpool exit at NE 6th Street from I-405.

From Seattle via SR 520

Take SR 520 east over the Evergreen Point Bridge to I-405 south, go south on I-405 and take Exit 13A west (NE 4th Street westbound) or Exit 13B (NE 8th Street west) or alternatively take the Bellevue Way Exit from SR 520 and proceed southbound on Bellevue Way into downtown.

From Seattle via I-90

Take I-90 east over Lake Washington, merge north onto I-405 (exit 10), proceed north on I-405 to Exit 13A or 13B NE 4th St. or NE 8th St. westbound.

From North - Everett, Bellingham, Vancouver B.C.

Take I-5 south to Exit 182 merge onto I-405 south toward Bellevue, take Exit 13A or 13B NE 4th St. or NE 8th St. westbound.

From South - Tacoma, Olympia

Take I-5 north to Exit 154 onto I-405 north toward Bellevue, take Exit 13A or 13B NE 4th St. or NE 8th St. westbound.

From East

Take I-90 west to Exit 10, merge onto I-405 north, then take NE 4th St. or NE 8th St. westbound.



Parking is available throughout downtown Bellevue with a combination of free and paid parking on surface lots and in parking structures. Check with your destination for more information.
