STATE OF ARKANSAS

Resuming Dine-in Operations: Phase One May 11

- Physical distancing between patrons and tables
- Reservations encouraged
- Face coverings
- Gloves for staff
- Daily staff screenings
- Frequent handwashing
- Pre-order when possible
- No groups over 10 people
- Senior hour encouraged
- No self-service
- Clean, disinfect tables, menus after each meal
- Bars and entertainment within restaurants prohibited
