## **WALKING TOUR OF COVENTRY**

#### **MORNING AND BREAKFAST**

Start your day with a <u>walking tour</u> of Medieval Coventry, led by Heart of England Blue Badge Guide, Roger Bailey. Discover the city's hidden gems, hear the legendary tale of Lady Godiva, and delve into Coventry's fascinating history.

## **COVENTRY CATHEDRAL**

Coventry Cathedral beautifully blends medieval history with stunning modern architecture. Explore the preserved ruins of the original cathedral, destroyed during a World War II air raid, and admire the iconic new cathedral, consecrated by Her Majesty the Queen in 1962. Don't miss the chance to climb the 14th-century tower for breathtaking views of the city and beyond.




