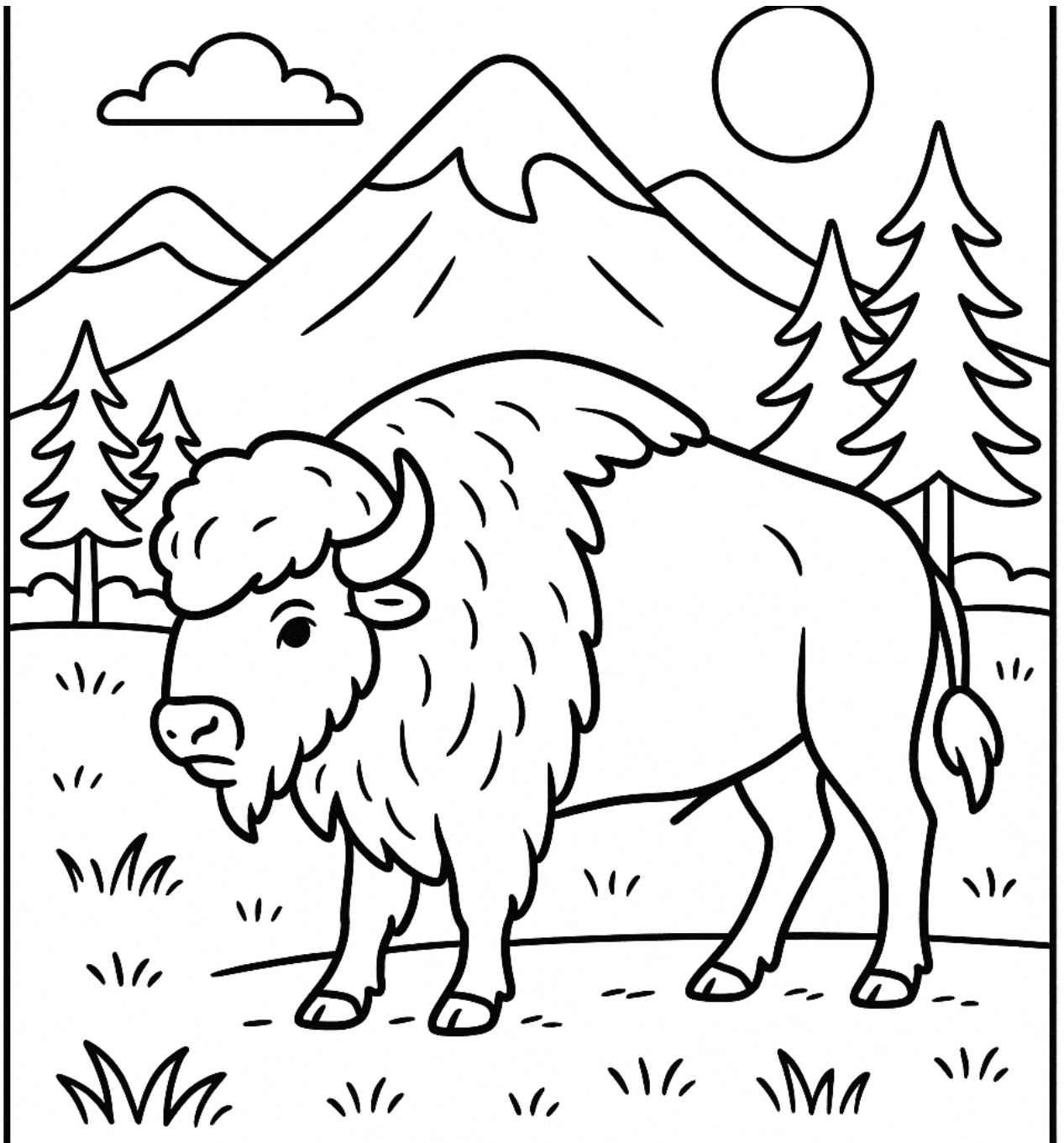

1. A Giant Herd Lives in the Black Hills!

Custer State Park has over 1,300 bison roaming free! Every fall, there's a big event called the Buffalo Roundup, where cowboys and cowgirls ride horses to gather the bison—just like in the Old West!

2. Bison Are Super Important to Native Americans

The Lakota people call the bison Tatanka. Long ago, bison gave them food, clothing, tools, and even shelter. Today, bison are still special and are part of many stories and traditions.
