This map illustrates the downtown area of Bloomington, Indiana, with a focus on pedestrian infrastructure for the 2025 Pedestrian Season. The map shows a grid of streets including Morton, College, Gentry, Washington, Lincoln, Grant, Dunn, Indiana, Kirby, Dunn, and Atwater. Key locations and features include:

- Landmarks and Buildings:** Monroe County Courthouse, Monroe County Public Library, Crazy Horse, Orbit Room, Metalworks, IU Parking After Hours, Peoples Park, BuffaLouie's, and Bloomington Fire Station 1 (HQ).
