

GENERAL ECLIPSE SAFETY TIPS:

- Make plans in advance for watching the eclipse.
- If you plan to look up at the eclipse, ensure that you have the proper eyewear.
- Stay informed about the weather. Make sure you are aware of any chance of severe weather.
- Ensure that your vehicle is safe to drive, especially if you are driving a long distance for the eclipse.
- Have an emergency supply kit inside your vehicle with essential supplies that could get you by for several hours or a few days. Long travel delays can be expected, and they can last for several hours.
- Know where the local fire stations, police departments, and hospitals are. If you have an emergency, call 911.
- Don't stop on any highway to view the eclipse.
- Expect congestion and delays. Be patient and watch your surroundings.
