

GENERAL ECLIPSE SAFETY TIPS:

Make plans in advance for watching the eclipse.

If you plan to look up at the eclipse, ensure that you have the proper eyewear.

Stay informed about the weather. Make sure you are aware of any chance of severe weather.

Ensure that your vehicle is safe to drive, especially if you are driving a long distance for the eclipse. Have an emergency supply kit inside your vehicle with essential supplies that could get you by for several hours

or a few days. Long travel delays can be expected, and they can last for several hours. Know where the local fire stations, police departments, and hospitals are. If you have an emergency, call 911.

Don't stop on any highway to view the eclipse.

Expect congestion and delays. Be patient and watch your surroundings.
