A PARKS

GREEN VALLEY PARK

Green Valley Community Park is a multi-purpose community park on the banks of the New River in Watauga County, NC. The park offers a picnic shelter, playground equipment, multi-purpose playing fields, hiking trails, and a canoe ramp.

COOK MEMORIAL PARK

Cook Park in historic Todd, NC is a perfect spot for picnics, fishing, or just chilling out by the river. It also hosts the Todd Summer Concerts Series with some of the finest musicians around and is home to the Todd New River Festival and the 4th of July Liberty Parade celebration.

TODD ISLAND PARK

Todd Island Park is a unique 5-acre island in the middle of the South Fork of the New River, about 3 miles downstream from the "downtown" Rural Historic District. A bridge was built over the north channel of the river to provide access from the parking lot.

The park is open from dawn until dusk and features a walking trail nearly a mile long that wraps around the perimeter of the island. From the trail, you can view the wildlife on the island and in the river, as well as native plants and trees. The trail also provides access to the south channel for easy fishing.



Designated as one of America's National Wild and Scenic Rivers, the New River is possibly the second oldest river on Earth, and certainly the oldest in North America. It is even thought to be older than any mountain range in the world - a fitting distinction given that the Appalachian Mountains are believed to be the world's oldest mountain range. The New River eroded and cut through the middle of the Appalachian Mountains as the range was forming. Its twisting path through the mountains exposes rocks that are over 1 billion years old. The river's headwaters begin near Blowing Rock, NC and flow through both Virginia and West Virginia - only one of 3 rivers in North America that flow north

PADDLING

FISHING REGULATIONS

 DELAYED HARVEST SECTIONS: Artificial lures only, single hook. See signage. at river for time-of-day restrictions. Look for black and white signs.

Non-trout species may be harvested from Delayed Harvest Trout Waters during the catch-and-release only trout season under applicable size and

- . HATCHERY SUPPORTED SECTIONS: No bait restriction, no minimum length, seven trout per day limit. Look for green and white signs.
- . BASS REGULATIONS: 14-inch minimum, except 2 may be less than 14 inches. Daily creel limit (number of fish) is 5 in combination, including only 2 below 14 inches.
