Preston was playing in a basketball game, a sport that he loved and excelled in, when he collapsed. Unbeknownst to Preston's family, he had a condition known as Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy which caused this episode and, ultimately, his passing after a courageous three-week battle with his family and friends at his side, and the unwavering support of medical professionals at Tufts Medical Center and Boston Children's Hospital.

The Settles Family has created the **Preston Settles Memorial Fund** to drive more awareness for this relatively rare condition, and to provide an opportunity for all high school athletes to have access to cardiograms that can catch congenital heart issues that can be deadly even if they don't include clear symptoms. In the true spirit of hospitality, and their fervent need to help others, the family has since created this fund. How fitting then, for us to come **together to help** for one of our very own. As such, all proceeds will go to their foundation. While this is just a small outward sign to the Settles family that their grief is ours, we want them to know that the entire Greater Boston hospitality community is there for them.
