Good evening,

Mayor Wu announced today that the City's COVID-19 vaccination mandate, which requires proof of vaccination for certain indoor areas, has been lifted. This decision is effective immediately as key public health benchmarks have been achieved: Boston has a 4.0% community positivity rate; 90.7% occupancy rate of adult ICU beds, and a 7-day average of adult COVID-19 hospitalizations at 195.9 per day.

Masks are still required in public indoor spaces, though this mandate will be reviewed by public health agencies over the next week.

The GBCVB will continue to monitor updates in the coming days and keep our partners apprised accordingly.
