


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








GETTING HERE



Driving Directions

From Denver: I-25 north onto Highway 36. Highway 36 (Boulder Turnpike) all the way into Boulder (becomes 28th Street). 28th Street to Pearl Street west (left turn). Pearl Street all the way into Downtown Boulder. Entrance to City Parking Garage (one of five) located at 16th Street south (left turn).

From the West: Heading east on I-70, exit onto I-25 north then onto Highway 36 (Boulder Turnpike). Highway 36 all the way into Boulder (becomes 28th Street).

From the East: Heading west on I-70, take the I-270 exit north (toward Fort Collins), take the Boulder exit (Hwy 36) heading west into Boulder (becomes 28th Street).

Directions from DIA: Take Peña Boulevard to I-70 west. Take I-70 west to the I-270 north exit (toward Fort Collins). Take I-270 north to the Hwy 36 west exit, toward Boulder. Continue on Hwy 36 to Boulder.

Transit Information

From Downtown Denver The Flatiron Flyer provides fast regional connections to/from Denver Civic Center and Union Station, and Downtown Boulder (and Boulder Junction), with stops along the newly constructed US 36 corridor. Look for the FF1 and FF2 schedules and learn more at rtd-denver.com/services/flatiron-flyer.

Throughout Boulder, the colorful HOP, SKIP, JUMP, BOUND, DASH, STAMPEDE and BOLT buses offer convenient travel around the city. There are several stops throughout Downtown Boulder. 

THE PEARL STREET MALL

No visit to Boulder is complete without a stroll down the world-famous Pearl Street Mall. This four-block walking mall is actually a city park! It is the historic heart of the city. Many of the buildings on the mall date back to the gold mining days of the 1880's and they have all been painstakingly restored to their original charm and elegance. In 2017, the mall celebrated its 40th anniversary and to this day is one of the most successful pedestrian malls in the country.


Teeming with visitors and locals alike on Colorado's signature sunny days, the mall has been described as the best place on the planet for people-watching and enjoying street entertainers. Buskers are plentiful year round and a variety of musicians compete for your ear on each of the four blocks of shade trees, fountains and flower gardens.

Kids can enjoy the natural play/interactive structures on each block of the mall - from the Weeping Rock on the 1100 block; the climbing rock play area on the 1200 block; the pop jet fountain on the 1300 block (summer months only) and the marble & brass animals on the 1400 block.

The mall is also home to shops, restaurants and art galleries including the world's biggest kite store, Colorado's largest kitchen & gourmet store, three bookstores and a co-op that is owned and run by local artists. Plus there are dozens of other "only in Boulder" venues – over 85 percent locally owned and operated! This amazing place is often called "Boulder's Living Room" by locals for the endless variety of events that take place year round. FOR THE LOVE OF THE EAST END

No visit to downtown Boulder would be complete without stepping off the bricks at 15th Street and heading east.

The East End district is for creative-spirits, foodies, adventure seekers & trend-setters. Located just steps off of the Pearl Street Mall, the East End encompasses seven blocks (from 15th to 21st streets) filled with delectable dining options and locally-owned shops filled with apparel, accessories and more.

This thriving Makers District features Todd Reed's incredible work space where his one-of-a-kind, hand-forged and finished jewelry made from recycled metals and sustainably-sourced raw and fancy-cut diamonds is crafted by master jewelers.

John Allen Woodward's retail space also houses his workshop where fine leather, silver and gold accessories such as signature belts, buckles, wallets, shoes, boots and bags are meticulously hand crafted.

Nearby neighbors include: Sherpani, whose unique and sustainable handbags, shoulder bags, travel bags and backpacks have been designed in Boulder for over a decade; Angie Star Jewelry whose pieces are a delicate balance between romantic and organic with subtle twists to traditional jewelry design; and By Elke who specializes in one-of-a-kind or small-run handmade leather & vintage canvas bags and accessories.




FOR THE LOVE OF THE WEST END




