



## DISPERSED CAMPING DECISION TREE

Along select portions of Forest Service roads, you may park and camp for **free** within 300 feet of the road, and at least 100 feet from water or wet areas. Recreate responsibly and Know Before You Go!

### ARE YOU READY TO GO?

- Are you comfortable being away from all amenities?
- Do you have plenty of water?
- Can your vehicle and yourself navigate potentially difficult 4-wheel drive roads?
- Are you comfortable being away from cell phone service?
- Does someone know where you are heading?
- Do you have a National Forest Visitor Map and Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) and know how to find legal dispersed camping areas?
- Do you know if roads are open or in a burned area? Or where to find that information?
- Have you checked the local weather?

### DO YOU HAVE WHAT YOU NEED?

- ✓ Maps and compass
- ✓ MVUM on your phone
- ✓ Drinking water for entire trip
- ✓ Sleeping bags
- ✓ Shelter and/or tents
- ✓ Extra clothing, rain gear, warm clothes, and sturdy boots
- ✓ Flashlight
- ✓ Cookware, matches, and enough food
- ✓ Insect repellent and sunscreen
- ✓ Blankets for your car
- ✓ Shovel and a full tank of gas
- ✓ Bags for taking trash home
- ✓ Trowel for digging 6 inch holes for poop
- ✓ Required Bear Resistant Food Storage container
- ✓ First Aid Kit

## Finding Dispersed Camping

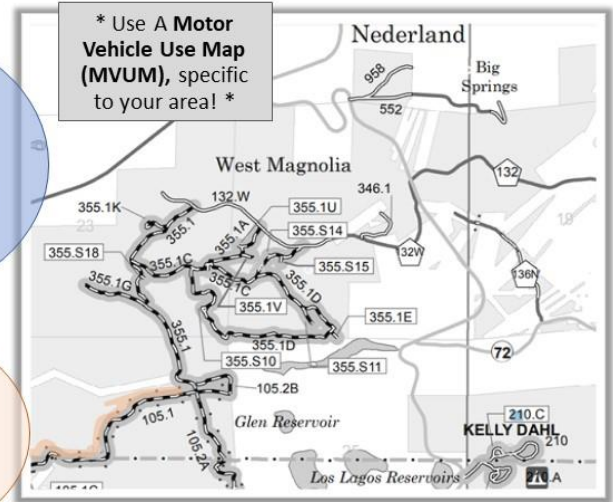
**Legend**

make sure a road is open before going by checking the "Roads Table" in the legend

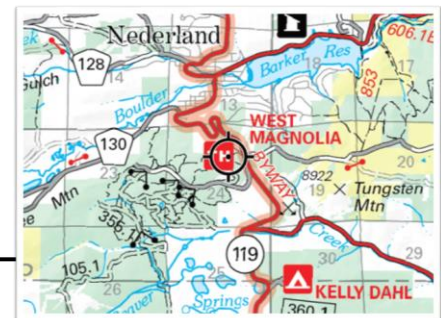
**Dots**
