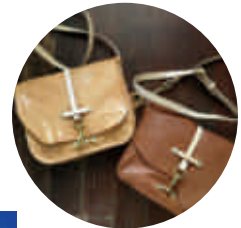

Former pro cyclist Will Frischkorn shares what he loves about home.

"I first visited Boulder in 1999. I was 17, training at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, and I remember thinking, I want to be part of this community.
