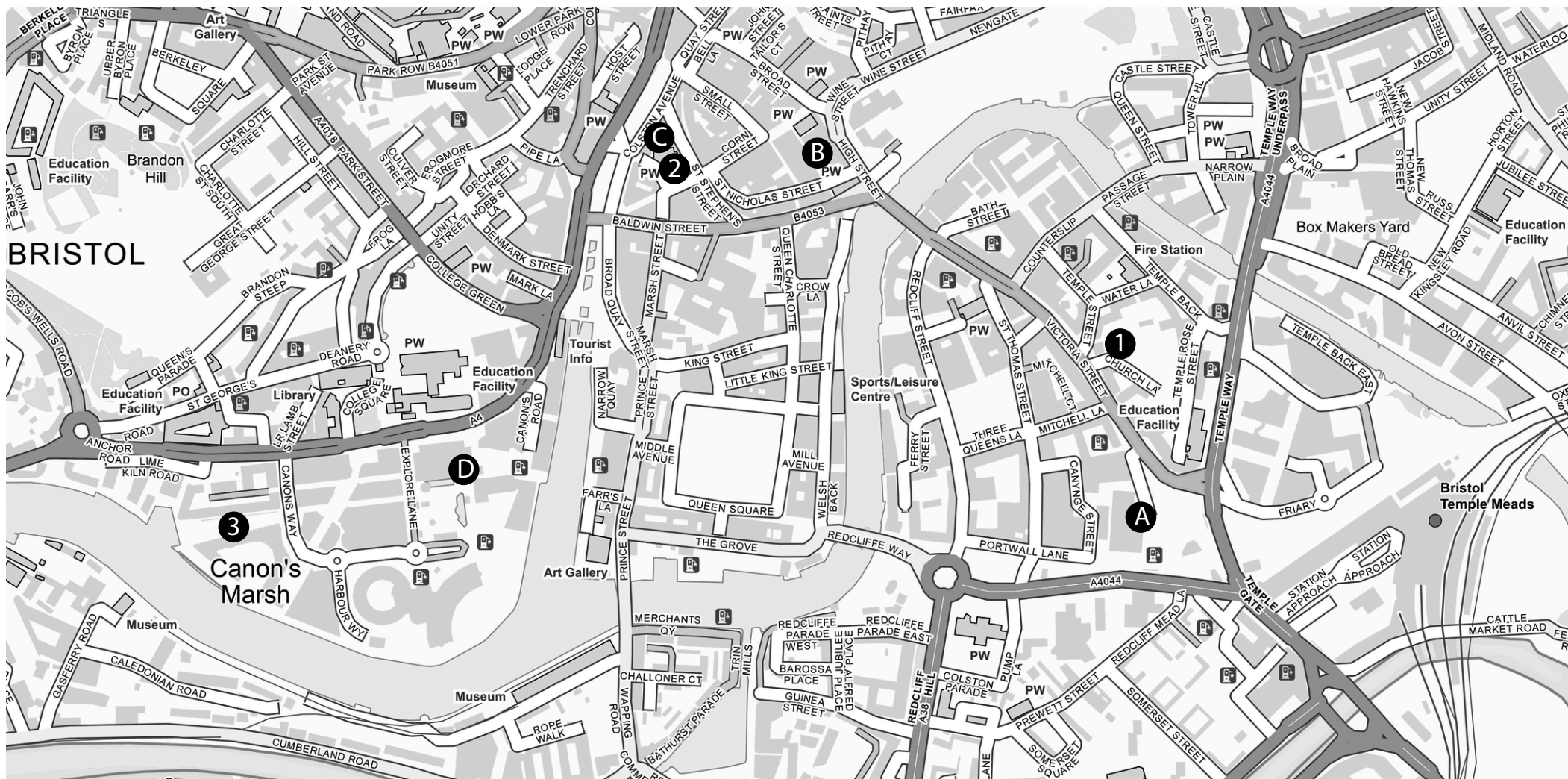

All locations are within Bristol City Centre, approximately 15–20 Minutes walk between locations

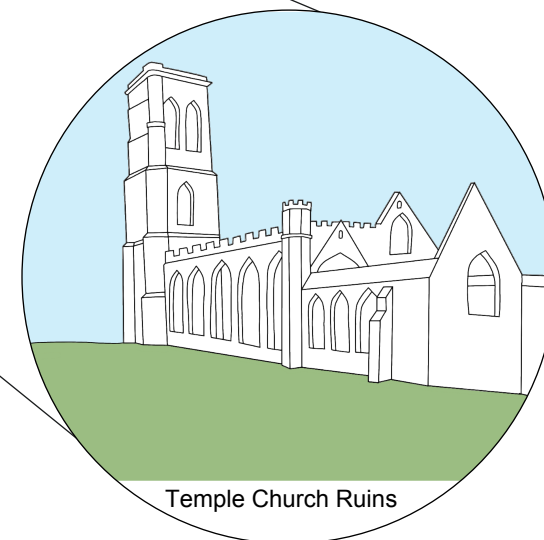
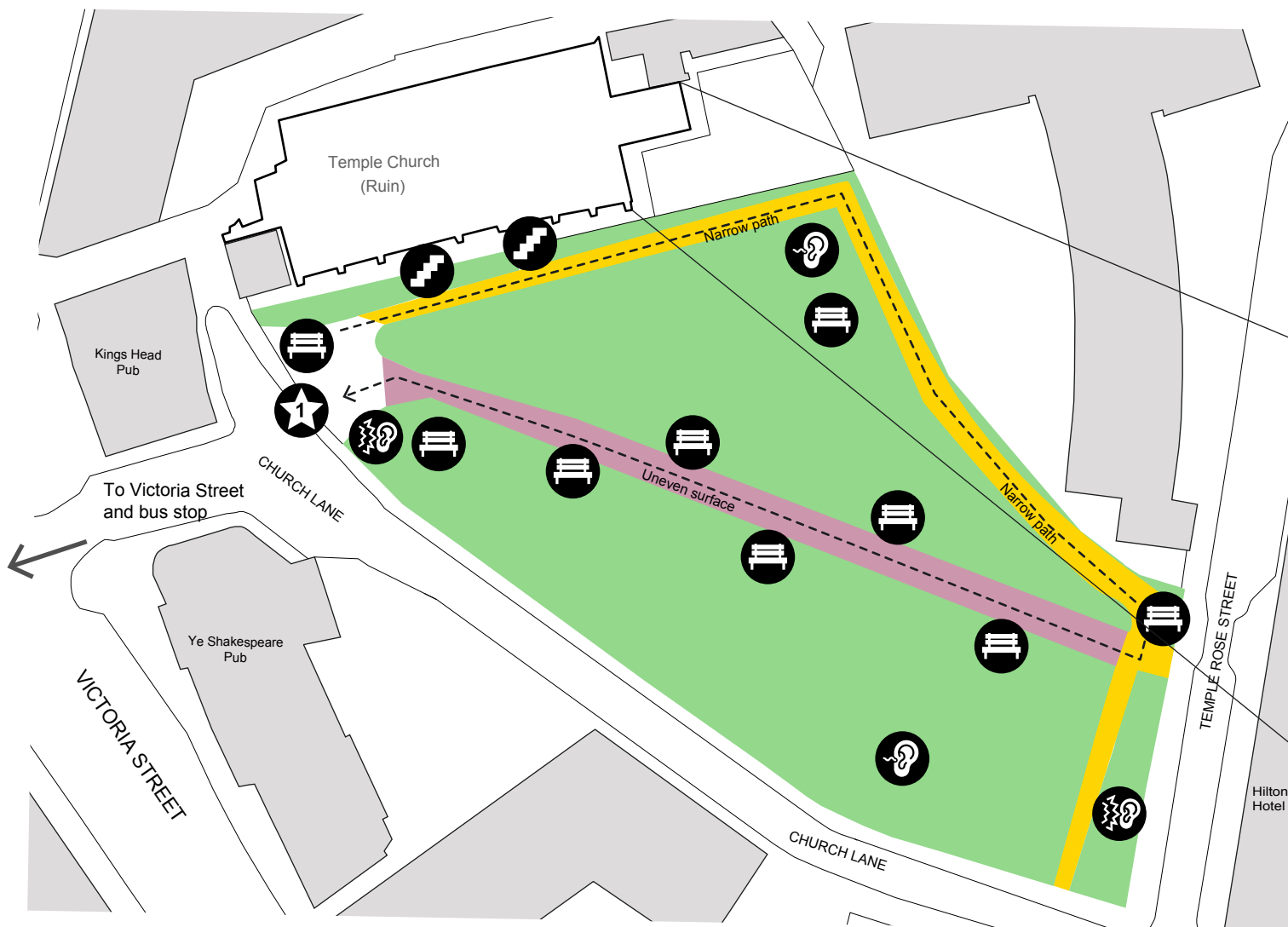
Temple Church Garden

Best for: Pausing or passing through

Open: 24 hours

Toilets: 0.3 miles away

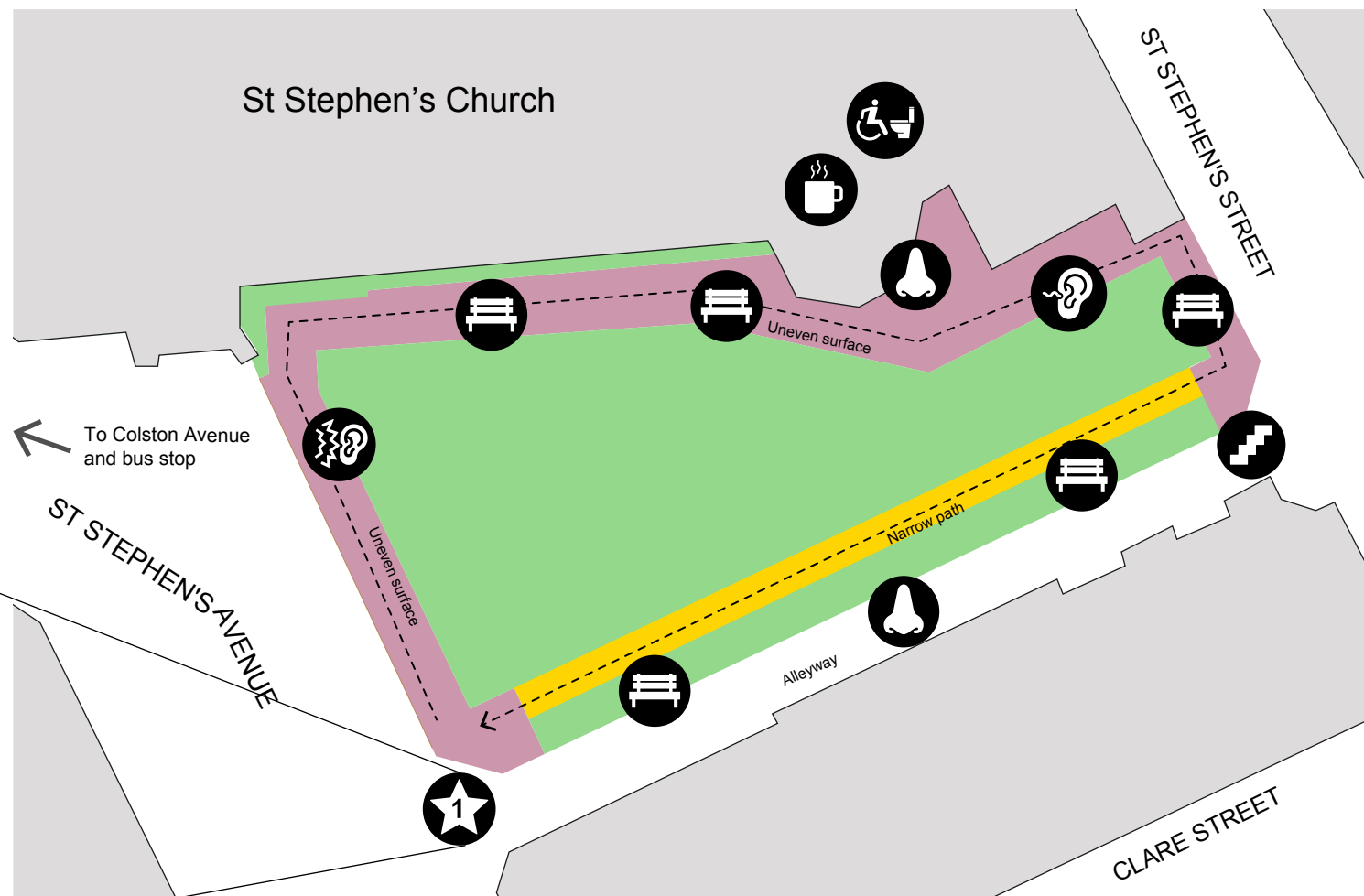
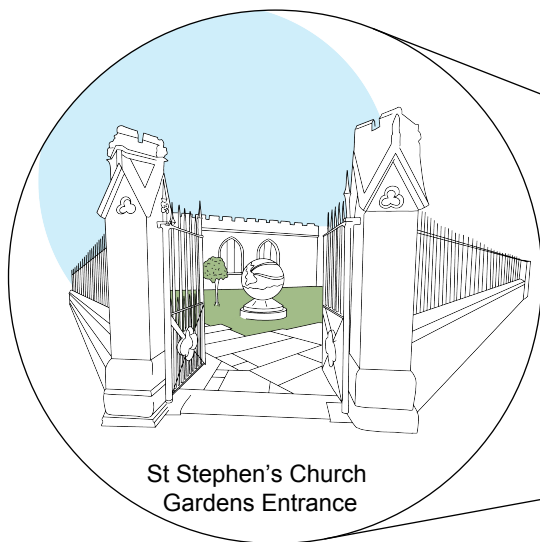
St Stephen's Church Garden

Quiet: Calm (can be busy), leaves rustling

Best for: Sitting. Enclosed, shaded

Open: 10am to 4pm daily

Toilets: on-site when the café is open.

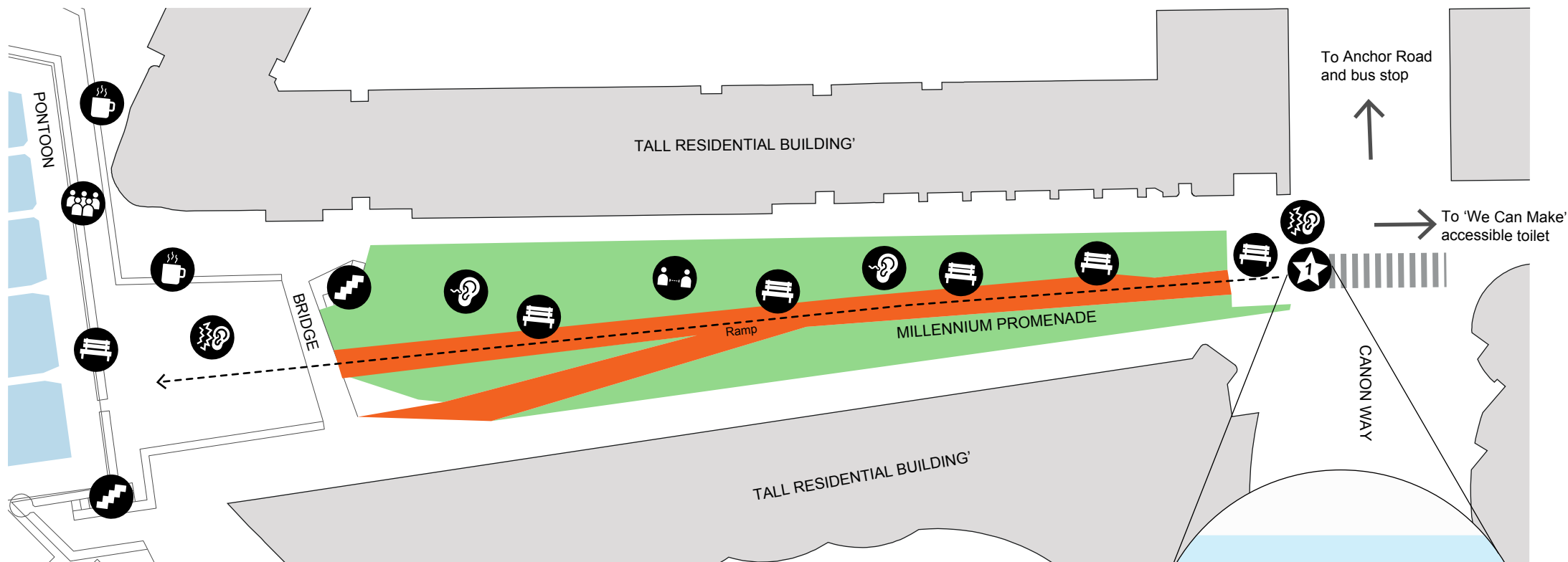

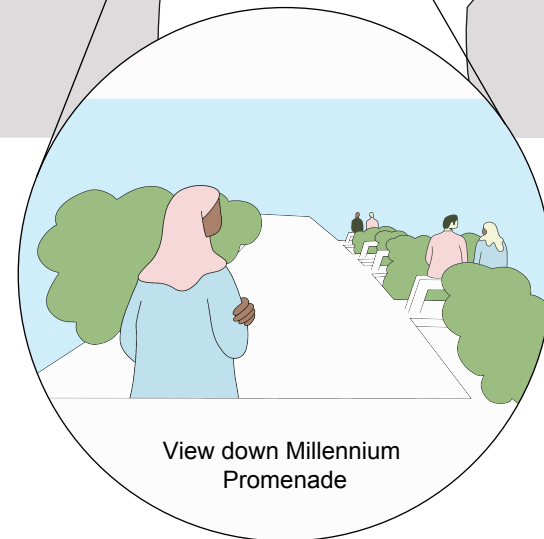
