All nominations are reviewed by the VBC Board Nominating Committee who will recommend candidates to the full VBC Board of Directors. The term is four years.

The tourism and hospitality industry is critical to the local Bucks County economy as visitor spending generates nearly \$1 billion in economic impact with a total hospitality workforce of more than 28,000. The VBC Board of Directors guides and supports the mission and programs executed by the organization. The Board also provides professional insights and resources to continue to move our destination forward.
