COVID-19 EVENT RISK MITIGATION PROCEDURE & GUIDELINES 2021 - Cannon Beach Fat Bike Festival

These procedures will be updated as necessary to follow the most current State of Oregon and Oregon Health Authority Risk Guidance & Sector Guidance for Outdoor Recreation. Waivers will be virtual and must be completed online and signed before event.

Please read all Guidelines before signing up for event. You are signing up understanding our Risk Mitigation Procedure & Guidelines and agree to comply with all rules. If you refuse to follow the set rules you will be asked to leave the event and no refund will be given. If you show any signs of COVID (see below) or are not feeling well before the event, we will refund your entry fee (minus ticketing fees).

We recommend you know the following before attending an event:

- Understand how <u>COVID-19 spreads</u>
- Understand the <u>Symptoms of COVID-19</u>
- If you are sick or are with someone who is sick **do not travel**.
- <u>People at Increased Risk</u> should not travel. Understand your risk level.
- Know the risks before you consider traveling.

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING EVENT

- All participants will be required to cover your mouth and nose with cloth face cover or mask when around others.
- Safety monitors will have radio coverage and limited cell phone coverage, have hand sanitizer with them as well as extra masks.
- Maintain 6' social distancing while on or off bike and avoid close contact with others.
- Cover your face for coughs and sneezing.

- Clean & disinfect all of your own personal gear.
- Avoid touching your face until hands are washed or sanitized.
- Wash your hands often with soap & water for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Riders are responsible to be self sufficient with food, hydration, tools and a face covering for anytime in venue area.
- No hugs, no high fives or fist bumping.
- Packet pick up on Friday will only allow a limited amount people in building at a time and social distancing of 6' will be maintained.
- Beach ride will follow 6 foot social distancing guidelines, have staggered start times and bikes will remain on North side of Hug Point and staff will monitor number of people walking Hug Point to waterfall to assure proper distances are maintained.
- Beach bonfire games & activities will be spread across several different areas to keep group sizes to a minimum and social distancing will be maintained on & off the bike. Face covering will be required when off bike and near others.
- Registrations for event will be based on where Clatsop County is currently (75 people as of 2/26/21) and will put others on a waitlist and let them in accordingly. Your registration will be refunded if county numbers change to allow less people before event and we will go by date of registration to know who is able to attend.
