

FAQ:

Do I need a special permit to ride my e-bike on the beach?

No, the event secures a special permit that allows e-bikes to ride on the beach during the festival. E-bikes are required to have a flag mounted to them while riding on the beach. The event will loan all e-bikes the required flag and mount them on your bike at check in on Friday.

Can I ride my e-bike at Klootchey Creek Trails for the Guided Sunday Ride?

The Klootchey Creek Trails are on private land and they do not allow any “throttled e-bikes.” Class 1 e-bikes which are pedal assist, are the only e-bikes allowed on the trails at Klootchey Creek.

Will my “acoustic” fat bike be fine to ride at Klootchey Creek Trails?

Yes, especially in the Spring, acoustic fat bikes will give you better traction on the trails at Klootchey Creek. The rides are guided group rides and they will adjust speeds and terrain for those that are riding.

How do I get to the Klootchey Creek Trails?

The Klootchey Creek Trail system is just 5 miles outside of Cannon Beach just off of HWY 26 @ Klootchey Creek County Park. Here is link on where to park & meet to ride the trails: Klootchey Creek [Google Map HERE!](#)

Do I need a permit to ride at Klootchey Creek Trails?

Yes, a free access permit is REQUIRED to ride at Klootchey Creek. It must be updated each year. You will be asked for your permit on site. [Click here](#) to sign up online. Create an account, then request an Oregon Permit. A printable vehicle placard and user card will immediately be available online.
