**Whale Migration Week/Whale Watching  
March 23-31**

Catch a glimpse of the more than 20,000 gray whales expected to migrate north past Oregon over the next few months. Gray whales migrate along the coast of the western U.S. annually during spring; they return to Alaskan waters after wintering in the warm lagoons off the coast of Baja, Mexico. Many of the gray whales are accompanied by their new calves, born during the winter. The first large groups of whales pass by Oregon mid-March and the migratory stream typically continues into June.

Trained volunteers will be stationed 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. each day at 24 sites along the coast, including Ecola State Park.
