The Cannon Beach Chamber presents the 32nd annual Stormy Weather Arts Festival. Since its inception, the first weekend in November has been a celebration of the arts in Cannon Beach. 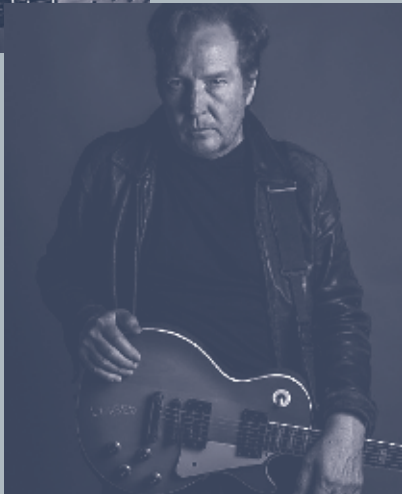

Marv & Rindy Ross are NW singer/songwriters who scored platinum success with their first album, 'Quarterflash', which included their hit, 'Harden My Heart'. The Rosses released 6 Quarterflash albums and toured with Elton John, Linda Ronstadt, and Jefferson Starship. In 1991 they formed The Trail Band and released 13 CDs with that group and produced a successful holiday concert series that ran for 25 years. The Rosses were presented the Meritorious Award for the contributions to music by their alma mater, Western Oregon University and were inducted into the Oregon Music Hall of Fame.

Jon Koonce is a NW guitarist, drummer, and singer/songwriter best known for his 80's group, **Jonny & The Distractions**. Signed by A&M Records, Jon went on to record two albums on that label and toured The Distractions extensively for over a decade. For the last 20 years Jon has written and recorded numerous albums both as a solo artist and with his bands. Recently he released the album, 'Lost Cause' and just completed, 'New American Blues' with Marv Ross and Doug Fraser. Jon was inducted into the Oregon Music Hall of Fame.

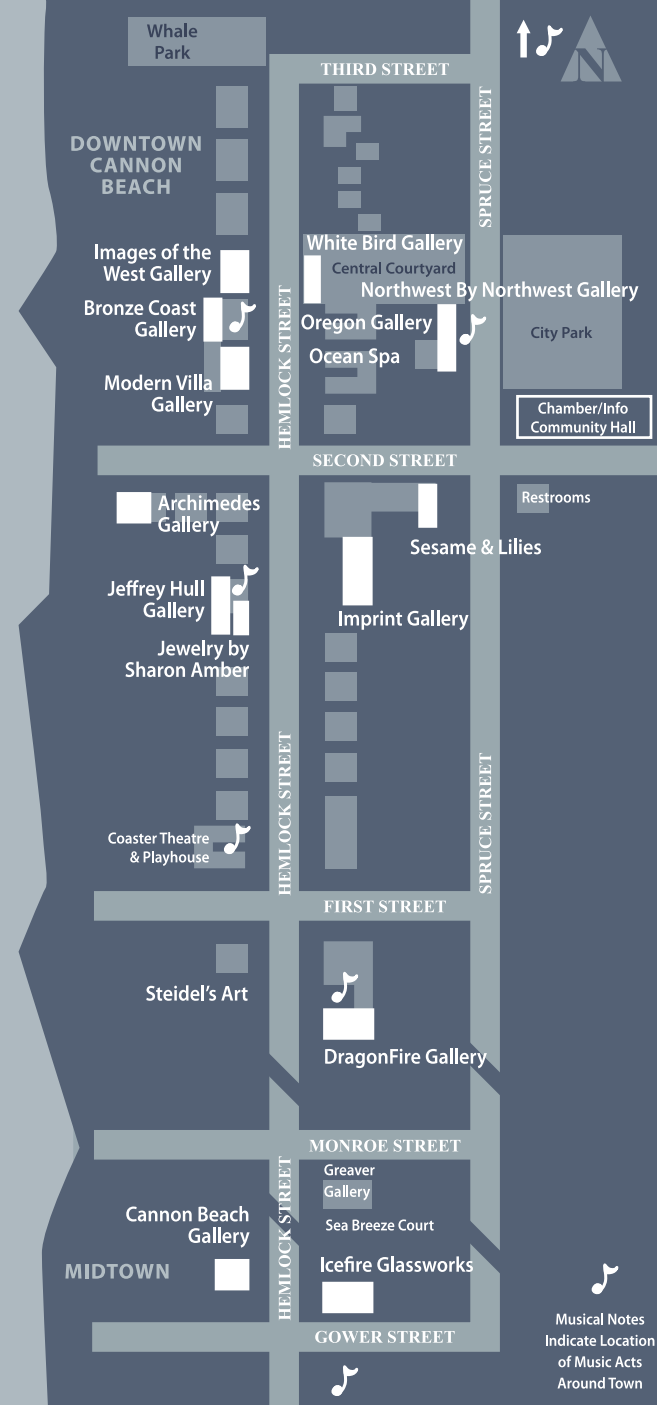
