



Sandcastle Contest began in 1964 when a tsunami washed out the Elk Creek Bridge and residents were relatively isolated until a new bridge could be built. That spring local families gathered for a Sandcastle Contest to entertain their children and attract visitors. That Sandcastle Contest became a local tradition and one of the largest sandcastle contests on the west coast. In 2015 the Sandcastle contest was awarded the Oregon Heritage Tradition designation that recognizes events more than 50 years old that represent what it means to be an Oregonian.
