### Barnstable

**Howe's Home Garden: 1124 Old Stage Road, Centerville**

**Tour benefiting Whelden Memorial Library 9:00 AM-12 Noon**

This lovely landscape holds numerous flower gardens with various perennials and bulbs. Their specialty is hybridizing day lilies. You will see plants that were cross-pollinated in 2017, yearlings planted in the spring of 2019 and blooming for the first time, and well over 100 plants saved from crops that date to 2004. The best hybrids get a Cape Cod name (Ex. Cape Cod Lemonade) and are registered with the American Hemerocallis Society. If you are curious about hybridization, or simply would like to enjoy an array of beautiful blooms, this is the garden to see. Orders taken for August pick-up. **Open for Tours: Saturday, July 11, Wednesday, July 15, and Sunday July 19.**

### Sandwich

**The Original Cocktail Hour Garden: 2 Lawrence Pond Lane, Sandwich**

Dan and C.L. Fornari are pleased to open their flower-filled landscape on Lawrence Pond. Find ideas for dry gardens in the bed along the road. See the organic vegetable garden that provides most of their produce from June through December. Discover "Annual Alley" where different combinations of colorful annuals are planted every year. C.L.'s test garden contains new varieties of shrubs and perennials, and the front-door garden is filled with a mix of perennials, annuals and shrubs. Visit the rain garden, a magical stumpery, many Hydrangeas and the Cocktail Hour Garden that inspired one of C.L.'s book.

**Accessibility:** Difficult – mulched paths, steep drive, uneven ground.

**Parking:** Some parking in the cul-de-sac but most parking will be on the side of Stowe Road. Be mindful of fast traffic on Stowe Rd and Farmersville.

**Directions:** From Garden #4, go back to Old Stage Road and turn right. Old Stage becomes Race Lane which turns into Farmersville Road in Sandwich. Pass the entrance to The Ridge Club (on your left) and the second right will be onto Stowe Road. Lawrence Pond Lane is immediately on your right. **Open for Tours: Friday, July 17 and Sunday, July 19.**
