CAREER CENTER

Training Opportunity Program (TOP)

Up to \$10,000 towards training eligible individuals whose skills are no longer in demand and who wish to enroll in a certificate program or earn and advanced license in order to find employment



On The Job Training Program (OJT)

Assists employers with the cost of hiring and training new employees. Reimburses employer for a percentage of the wages during the pre-agreed training period

Large-Scale: 2-Yr Training Projects
Strategic & Customized

- \$250,000 maximum / 2-year grant

- Company must match grant funds \$1-to-\$1 (includes wage/fringe paid to trainees)
- Outcome tracking & reporting required
- Applicant works w/ trainer(s) of choice
