CONGRESSMAN BILL KEATING TO HEADLINE CAPE COD CHAMBER LEGISLATIVE EVENT

WHAT: The Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce hosts a Cape & Islands Legislative Breakfast event

HYANNIS, MA – The Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce the Cape & Islands Legislative Breakfast, scheduled for Friday, April 10 at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel. The event will feature an extensive program of speakers, with elected officials and government leaders from the local, regional, state, and federal levels sharing updates specifically for the Cape Cod business community. Congressman Bill Keating, U.S. Representative for the Massachusetts 9th Congressional District, will headline the event. Congressman Keating’s remarks will focus on federal actions that are shaping Cape Cod’s economic and civic future, including ongoing work to fund and replace the Sagamore and Bourne Bridges.

Douglas Howgate, President of the Massachusetts Taxpayers Foundation, will share recent analysis on policy and budget shifts at the federal level, and how these may impact the Commonwealth and businesses.

Mark Forest, Barnstable County Commissioner, will moderate a local government panel, featuring **Peter Lombardi, Brewster Town Manager; Kim Newman, Orleans Town Manager; Mike Renshaw, Falmouth Town Manager; and Bob Whritenour, Yarmouth Town Manager**. The panel discussion will highlight how municipal leaders are navigating regional economic challenges and share examples of town-led initiatives that support business success.

Rob Galibois, Cape and Islands District Attorney, will provide an overview of regional public safety resources for businesses.
