## **Cape Cod Chamber Launches Small Business Series**

**Cape Cod, MA:** This spring, the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce will launch the Small Business Series in partnership with MassHire Cape & Islands Career Center. The Small Business Series is a recurring 30-minute, virtual, lunchtime presentation that puts local and regional business development experts in front of small, local businesses.

Throughout the series, speakers will share small business best practices, invaluable resources, and actionable tasks to help develop and grow their business. The Cape Cod Chamber will work with MassHire Cape & Islands Career Center, SCORE Cape Cod & the Islands, and the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) to welcome speakers with expertise and experiences on topics and needs identified by the Cape Cod Chamber and its membership.

In the first session, to be held at noon on Monday, March 21st, a panel of three speakers will share how their organizations support small businesses in our region. Panelists include Neila Neary of MassHire Cape & Islands Career Center; Caroline Williams of the U.S. Small Business Association; and Marc Goldberg of SCORE Cape & the Islands.

The Cape Cod Chamber's free Small Business Series will be held every other Monday now through the end of May and will resume in the Fall of 2022. April and May sessions will focus on employee recruitment and retention.
